Dear Mark:

Enclosed you will find the forms which we discussed by telephone today in connection with the contemplated Simpson Well No. 1, NW/4 NE/4 Section 21, Township 10 North, Range 23 East, NMPM, Guadalupe County, New Mexico.

I have sent you the \$5,000.00 one-well bond form, which must be approved by this office before the well is spudded. In fact, it is the "prime mover" from which the C-101 must be approved (the Notice of Intention to Drill). It must be written by a surety company authorized to do business in New Mexico, and countersigned by a resident New Mexico agent, if written outside the state.

Guadalupe County falls within the Commission's District IV. The C-101 and all subsequent forms should therefore be sent to this office, marked to the attention of E. A. Chaves, oil and gas inspector for the district. I am enclosing a supply of forms for use as the work progresses.

The name of the operator as shown on the bond must be in agreement with the name shown on all forms relating to the well.
