1. Spudded 12-16-57. Drilled 7-7/8 inch hole to 557 feet. Reamed to 17" diameter to 552 feet.
2. Set 13-3/8", 54.50#, J-55, 8R Thd., ST&C casing at 552 feet. Cemented with 350 sacks common cement. Cement circulated to surface.
3. Nippled up. Tested casing and BOP to 800 psi for 30 minutes. Held o. k.
4. Drilled cement plug, resumed drilling formation with 7 7/8" bit.
