1. Spudded 7-24-56. Drilled 12-1/4 inch hole to 500 feet and reamed to 17-1/2 inch to 310 feet.
2. Set 13-3/8 inch 54.50#, J-55, 8R Tnd., ST&C casing at 310. Cemented with 230 sacks common cement.
3. Nippled up. Tested casing and BOP to 800 PSI for 30 minutes. Held O. K.
4. Drilled cement plug and 60 feet of new hole to 560 feet. Casing parted at 193 feet.
