1. Circulated hole with drilling mud, 9.5#/gal.
2. Set 5 sack cement plug in top of 13-3/8 inch casing.
3. Welded steel plate with 4 inch steel marker as required in Rule 202(a) across top of 13-3/8 inch casing, sealing same.
4. Filled pits, levelled location, removed all debris. Location now ready for inspection.

Note: This hole prematurely abandoned due to parted surface casing. Well No. 2-A drilled 20 feet east of this location. See Form C-103 for Well No. 2-A.

* Date well was plugged. Cleaning location and levelling pits completed June 17, 1957.
