2. Set 9-5/8", 32# National casing at 418/300 sacks neat cement. Cement circulated to surface. Plugged down at 6.25 A. M. October 7, 1958.
3. Tested 9-5/8" casing and blow out preventors to 800 psi. Held for 30 minutes with no loss of pressure.
4. Resumed drilling on October 9, 1958.
