Dear Mr. Hankins:

On April 19, 1974, I discussed with you (by telephone) the lack of information pertaining to your Virginia Branch Well No. 1 in Guadalupe County, New Mexico. On May 1, 1974, you sent this office a letter which states the well has been temporarily abandoned. In a reply to that letter, I sent you a copy of the Oil Conservation Commission regulations concerning temporarily abandoned wells and wells which are to be converted for fresh water supply. Forms to be used for such conversions were also sent you.

To date this office has received no reply. According to our files, total depth of 1240' was reached on February 3, 1967, and the well temporarily abandoned. Your Form C-105, signed by Donna Holles, is dated June 13, 1973. A scouting service report gives your completion date as July 29, 1968. We have not yet received the Form C-103 required by Rule 202 (b). From this it is apparent that some action must be taken to attain compliance with Commission regulations.

Kindly fill out and submit the necessary forms for the above named well prior to January 15, 1975, to avoid legal action.
