Dear Mrs. Connor:

I have your letter of July 21 and accompanying Forms C-102 on the proposed work at the Iceco CO<sub>2</sub> gas wells in Harding County. Enclosed is your approved copy.

I realize that it was too early to predict the exact programs that would be needed for each well. Consequently I shall be anticipating a detailed account of all remedial work done on each well. Iceco has plant men at the Bueyeros that should be able to witness the work and relay to you all necessary details. It would assist you if this were done in writing rather than over the radio. Similarly an account of the work done by the service company or contractor submitted to you on their own service (charge) forms or stationary would assist you in your final reports for each well.

I have been advised indirectly by Messrs. Seth and Montgomery and Mr. Libby that work has started on the Iceco wells. I do not know however, the name of the service company, the exact date when such work commenced, or on what well they started.
