Dear Mrs. Connor:

I have your letter of July 21 and accompanying Forms C-102 on the proposed work at the Iceco CO₂ gas wells in Harding County. Enclosed is your approved copy.

I realize that it was too early to predict the exact programs that would be needed for each well. Consequently I shall be anticipating a detailed account of all remedial work done on each well. 
