

Field Notes of survey made Sept 1950

for Adams & McGahy of Amarillo Tex

To find center point of NW⁴NE⁴ Sec 16, -21N-30E

Weather clear & warm.

Party D.S. Durbin Inst.

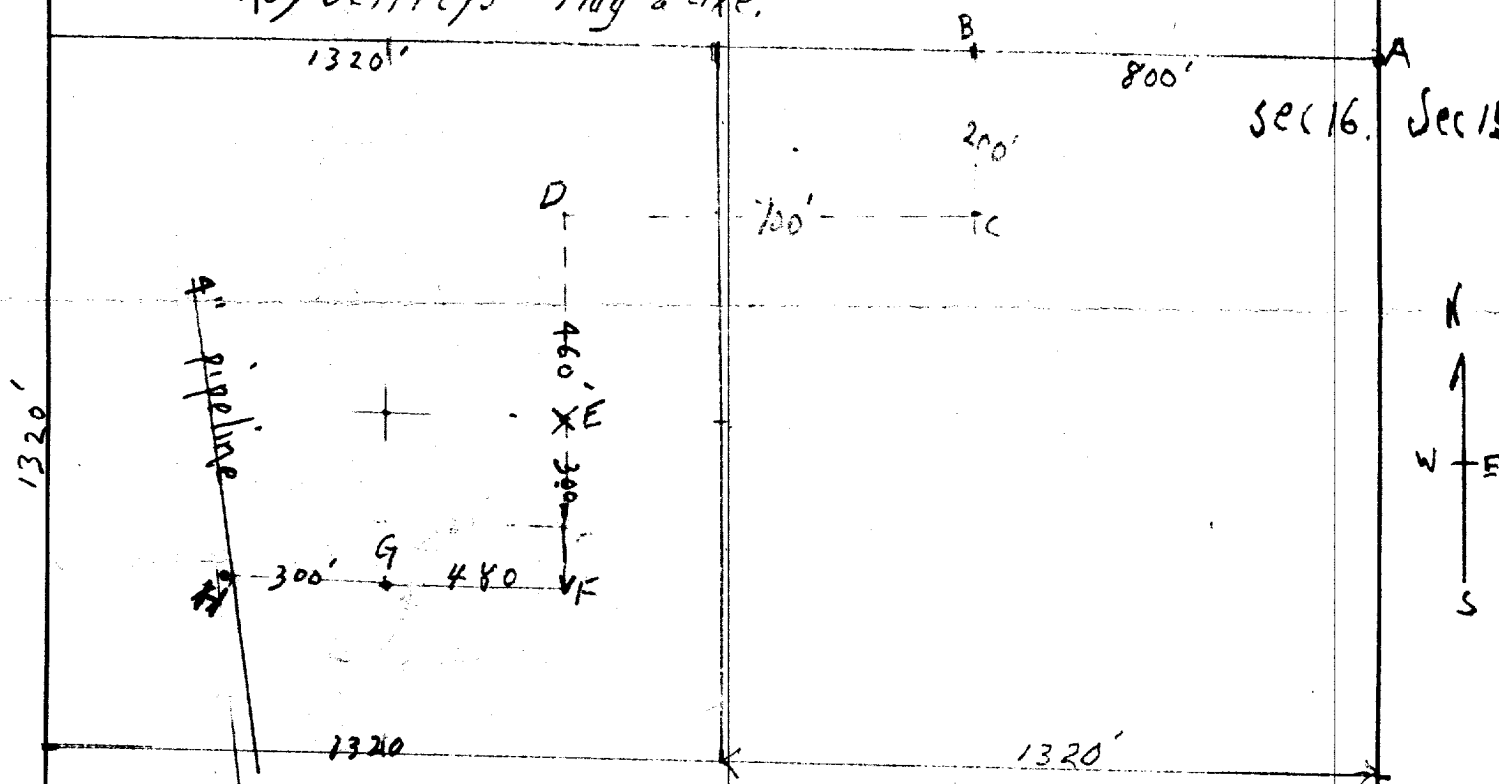

Scale 1 1/4" = 1 mile 1 inch = 337' approx.

Began at cor common to Secs 9-10-15-16, T21N, R30E N.M.M. where I found sandstone set firmly in ground and marked on S. side and on E. side. and also by a corner fence post with anchors (fences are gone).

With inst at this corner (A) ran W 800' to B - set stake and with inst at B ran S 200' to C. - With inst at C ran W 700' to D on top N & W side rocky arroyo. From D ran S 460' to point E. From E ran S for offset 300' to F. From F ran W 480' to G - 300' S from our sought center point. From G ran W on same line as offset 300' to H. Set stake in mound of stones at this point being 1 foot W of 4" pipeline and 100' S and W from rock escarpment and on smooth ground. The many offsets were made to avoid high rock cliffs. Our final point H is 300' S and 300' W from the center of NW⁴NE⁴ Sec 16, T21N R30E N.M.M. Harding Co N.M. which is inaccessible.
