Dear Mr. Haskins:

On June 28, 1970, you applied for a permit to drill a well on the Arthur Cain Ranch, to be located 660 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the west line of Section 4, Township 15 North, Range 33 East, NMPM. You were given approval for this proposed 1500 foot wildcat on July 1, 1970. Since then, this office has received no further reports or data from you.

There is reason to believe you drilled (or caused to be drilled) the described well. Kindly submit all of the reports and data relating thereto - as specified by Oil Conservation Commission Regulations - prior to September 1, 1974.
