Dear Mr. Haskins:

To date we have received no reports for work done on your No. 1 Federal 17 well, located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 17, T. 15 N., R. 33 E., Harding County, New Mexico, on Federal lease NM 2194. The Code of Federal Regulations provide that all major work such as spudding, casing details and test results be promptly reported in writing.

Please furnish this office with five copies of Sundry Notice, form 9-331, (blank copies attached) outlining in detail the work accomplished and methods employed, including all dates. State law provides that two of the requested five copies of the report be furnished to the New Mexico Oil and Gas Conservation Commission through this office.

If you intend any of the well information to be kept confidential, you should so request. You should contact this office prior to any plugging operations. We will need to be advised of formation tops and oil, gas, or water zones in order to furnish you with an acceptable plugging program.

I plan to visit your operations in the very near future and will probably see you there.
