Dear Mr. Schoenbrun:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation of last week, I will try to explain in detailed information I need to file with the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico.

To help clarify this, I am attaching a Xerox copy of letter addressed to me from the Oil Conservation Commission and signed by Mr. Carl Ulvog, Senior Geologist. This letter was dated December 2, 1975, and I have been trying since that time to obtain this information.

I need all records of the wells drilled by Olympic in Section 27, Township 16 North, Range 33 East, NMPM Harding County, New Mexico. The casing record, the treating record, the plugging records and cementing records, these records should be in the files of Olympic.

As stated in my phone conversation with you last week, I had nothing to do with the drilling of this well. Olympic did not have a plugging bond, Astro-Tex did, and I let them use Astro-Tex to drill this well with the complete understanding that all operations would be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico.

I have been informed that a bulldozer man was paid for clearing the location by Olympic. The location, as of December 2, 1976 had not been cleared. If you could furnish me with the man's name who was paid for this work it would be very helpful. Perhaps you could find the man who paid for the work, he could tell who the man was.

Any information concerning the above-mentioned well will be greatly appreciated.
