Dear Mr. Ulvog:

Since our last phone conversation and your letter of December 2, 1975, regarding the above captioned wells, I have been diligently searching for information concerning these wells, making many long distance calls, writing letters, and so forth.

The Olympic Oil Corporation was taken over by a receiver and this makes the search more difficult, however, I have come up with some information which is enclosed.

I am enclosing a copy of a letter from Olympic signed by Ruth Nolan who is working for the receiver. As per her letter, I am enclosing herewith all the information she found in the files pertaining to these wells. The first well was lost and they moved over drilled No. #1-A and according to enclosed information 2911 was T.D. on the #1-A. 2308 ft. of 4 1/2" pipe was set in a 7 7/78 hole cemented with 325 sacks class C cement. The engineering report on Logan #1-A enclosed gives formations that were perforated with no results in any of the zones tested. The copies of reports I filed were sent to me as being correct and I signed them and sent them to Oil and Gas Commission. The two wells were plugged on about the same dates.
