I request OXY USA Inc. be granted approval for a 168 hour flowback period (after load recovery) on the following West Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide Gas Unit wells located in Harding County, New Mexico:

WBDCDGU #13 1980' FNL & FWL, Sec 7, T-18-N, R-30-E. WBDCDGU #15 1980' FNL & FWL, Sec 29, T-19-N, R-29-E. WBDCDGU #16 1980' FNL & FWL, Sec 21, T-18-N, R-29-E.

The above wells have been scheduled for remedial stimulation work in the near future and it will be necessary to vent ${\rm CO_2}$ to the atmosphere during followup testing. The work is tentatively planned to begin during the week of July 24, 1989.
