Therefore, since we can find no one responsible for the said well, and since our bond still applies to this well, we, of course, would like to have the well plugged and have our responsibility under the above bond terminated.

Therefore, it would seem it's up to our company to plug the well, and, therefore, I am requesting information from you concerning the proper procedure to follow to plug this well. I imagine it would be our responsibility now to have some drilling company go out and plug the well according to your requirements. Therefore, will you kindly advise the proper procedure to follow in having this well plugged, and I in turn will contact some drilling company and have the necessary done according to your specifications. Will you please advise at your very earliest convenience.
