

BOND FOR COMPLIANCE WITH NEW MEXICO LAWS  
AND RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE GEOLOGIST DEALING  
WITH OIL AND GAS ORIGIN PRIVATELY OWNED LANDS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:
