Reference is made to your letter of June 25, 1956, wherein you advise that the above-captioned well has been completed.

Our understanding of the matter is that the original well, to be located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 30, Township 20 North, Range 31 East, was abandoned, and a new location drilled.

As per our letter of June 26, 1956, a C-102, Notice of Intention to Plug, and C-103, Report on Plugging, must be filed on the original well. A new C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, together with Surveyor's Plats, must be filed and approved for this second well. I suggest that inasmuch as the first well was named the Schwartz No. 1, the second well be named the Schwartz No. 1-X, which is customary procedure when a second well is drilled on the same lot.

You are also reminded that Form C-103 must be filed for each casing string, and that C-105, Well Record, must also be filed.

I am enclosing a supply of the various forms required as well as a brief summary of instructions in the filing of forms required by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for the drilling of oil, gas, and/or carbon dioxide wells, for your convenience.
