KUMMBECA OIL AND GAS COMPANY (UNINC.)
(a closed company, no stock having been sold)

Location: North Central Portion of Section 34, Range 30, East Township 21, North, Bueyeros, Harding County, New Mexico, being 32 miles south and east of Roy, New Mexico.

Well No. 1 bottomed at 970 feet. Only small portion of productive sand pierced. Acreage, 11,000 acres all deeded, no government permit. Embracing the cream of the DeBaca Structure.

Well brought in May 18, 1931 with flow of gas officially tested by U. S. Bureau of Mines from the Helium Institute offices at Amarilla, Texas by Messers. Deaton, Ports and Anderson showing 2,654,000 cubic feet each twenty-four hours of 98% pure CO_2 gas. Flow increasing on May 20, 1931 in an open 10 inch whole.

U. S. & G. S. well men from proper division now enroute to advise proper handling of flow of gas.

Well location situated from 18 to 20 miles from new proposed Colmor cut off Railway at AT and S.F.

Water available. Desirable drinking water available at shallow depth.

No main artery highways, but fairly good passable roads by South and East Via Roy and Clayton, New Mexico and up west from main arteries of highways via Springer, Las Vegas and Wagon Mound, New Mexico. Ute Creek supplying water for limited irrigation purposes. Buttes some 24 miles in area. Structure presents great possibilities inasmuch as practically proven area six miles long, the greater portion of which is upon our acreage. Lower end of sand structure having been drilled and a producer of approximately the same amount and quality of gas in year 1918. This well was closed inasmuch as inflammable gas at this time was of no known value.
