We propose to test the casing shut off at such time in the near future as shall meet the convenience of a representative of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to be present. The well is cased to a depth of 1926 feet, with 8 1/2" casing, 32 pounds to the foot, fully cemented from top to bottom with Halliburton Process, using 450 sacks of cement; total depth of well 2102 feet to what appeared to be granite.
