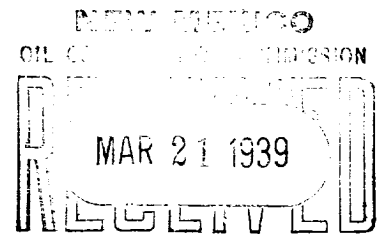

Gentlemen:

This refers to Mr. Andreas' letter of March 9th and Mr. Pettit's letter of March 17th and the conference between Mr. Andreas and the writer on March 9th last.

We enclose herewith, in triplicate, executed copies of Forms 101 and 103, which we trust will be found in proper form and to furnish the desired information. We have prepared and are forwarding to Mr. Marantette, the General Manager, Form 102, Intention to Test Well, which, when executed, he will send direct to you. We are also asking him to prepare and forward to you, in triplicate, Form C-105, the Well Record and Log. We do not have the information in the office to enable us to prepare this form. We are also forwarding to him Form of Bond 39-B1, which has been executed by the surety, and he will forward it to you as soon as he executes it in behalf of the company. We are also requesting him to have prepared as soon as possible a map of our pipe line from the wells to the plant, a copy of which will be furnished you in due course.

We are also passing on to him the information given us by Mr. Andreas that you have only received Form C101 with respect to our Well No. 2. We had thought all necessary information with respect to that had been furnished, except the log. We understand that Forms C-102 and C-103 and C-105 remain to be furnished with respect to No. 2 and are so advising Mr. Marantette.


