Thank you for your letter of May 19 in response to our inquiry concerning the above captioned well. We are waiting with interest your further comments concerning this case.

Also, if it would not be too inconvenient, we would appreciate a little information concerning the process used to plug a well; the materials used and how it is accomplished to prevent one strata from impregnating others.

We have no available information as to what constitutes the plugging of a well and the exact process, although I believe the primary concern is to prevent foreign substances from entering any strata of natural resources.

We shall appreciate very much any information you can give us on this subject.
