Set a cement plug from 250 feet to 100 feet, then fill the hole with drilling mud to within fifteen feet of the surface. From that point set a cement plug to the surface and set a permanent four foot high well marker four inches in diameter in the plug. Pits must be filled and the location leveled and cleared of junk.
