Dear Mr. Reese:

Your company is the record owner of the above described operation. As such, you need to be aware that a report (or a series of reports) concerning same is much overdue. Attached hereto is a copy of portions of New Mexico regulations concerning wells drilled for hydrocarbons.

The last report pertaining to the subject well received in this office is dated October 16, 1975 and is a notice of the commencement of drilling operations and setting of 7" casing at 1059' with total depth at 2916'. You will note that Rule 1103 requires that: (a) if well was temporarily abandoned, a report of same should have been filed by October 26, 1975; (b) if well was plugged a report of same was due by November 15, 1975. If well was completed as a producer, the completion report and well logs were due 20 days later. If no work was done on the well after October 16, 1975, and well was neither plugged nor completed as a producer, then Rule 202 required that the well be plugged by December 15, 1975, unless a permit for temporary abandonment was previously obtained from the Commission.

In view of the foregoing, it appears that the Commission has no choice but to order the well properly

plugged and abandoned. Thus if immediate action is not taken to furnish this office with all of the logs, reports and data which is long overdue, the matter will be referred to our Legal Department.
