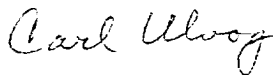
Gentlemen:

On August 15, 1974, you applied for a permit to drill (Form C-101) a well in Unit N of Section 9, Township 21 North, Range 21 East, NMPM, Mora County, New Mexico. No additional reports concerning such an operation have been received by this office.

On October 23, 1974, an inspection of the above described location revealed that a well has indeed been drilled there and completed as a gas well. On October 8th of this year a newspaper item discussed this well and referred to it as a "Dakota gas discovery."

Kindly refer to Rule 103 and Rule 117 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Regulations and be governed accordingly.
