Dear Mr. Ulvog,

I enclose herewith Form C-103 in triplicate as a subsequent report of casing test and cement job on Mora Ranch #3, located on Section 5, T21N, R21E, Mora County, New Mexico. According to our records this information was originally sent March 27, 1978. However, we resubmit the report in the event you are unable to find it in your files.

Also enclosed please find a Change of Operator report filed on C-103 to change the operator of the above mentioned well from Yates Exploration Company, Inc. to Coronado Exploration Corp. We had originally filed this on Form C-104 after talking on April 7, 1978 to a woman who answered 827-2434 and who told me C-104 was the correct form, to be filed in triplicate. When the forms arrived they did not initially appear to fit what I needed, so I called again on April 10 to the same number and discussed the problem with someone, perhaps the same person, who promised to investigate further and let me know. She sent more C-104s with a note, a copy of which is enclosed. April 14, 1978 I called your office at 827-2533 to confirm this. You were out, but your secretary assured me that C-104 was indeed what was required. Obviously, the confusion lay in the difference between a drilling well and a producing well, and was never clarified by either side.

The third set of C-103s enclosed covers an interim report for Simms #1, located on Section 9, T21N, R21E. This well has been in limbo while the operator was changed, and hopefully the problem of communication will be alleviated by the new operator.

With the use of all these C-103s, our stock is depleted. Could you please send us some more? In the future we will attempt to be more prompt in their filing.
