Regarding the formation tops you reported on Form C-105, Well Record, was the Glorieta picked from sample data or electric log data? Similarly, could you augment this information with additional tops above and below the Glorieta including the geologic formation at the surface?

Concerning the cutting's samples, I had verbally instructed Mr. William Vick to see that the samples were delivered to the Hobbs sample cut (N.M. Oil Scouts Assoc.). Please advise me what has been done about the samples. If they are cleared through the Hobbs cut we will automatically receive our cut.
