Inspected: October 19, 1951

This is an old well drilled by Paul Kaiser several years ago and is located about 1/2 mile directly south of the Cox-Berlier. There is a cellar approximately 4' x 4' x 3' which is open. The 10" casing is capped inside the cellar. There is a considerable amount of gas leakage blowing thru the soft earth outside the casing. I would recommend that we have this situation taken care of regardless of whether the gas is marketable or not.

There is a definite petroleum odour to this gas, I suspect however, that it is a CO₂ Hydrocarbon gas mixture.
