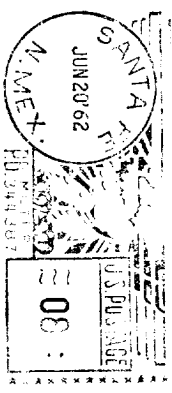


Gentlemen:



Your letter of June 4th, 1962 was forwarded to me from  
Springer, N. M., and I regret the delay.

After filing my report Form C-102 I came home from New Mexico  
and do not know what work was performed on the captioned well  
after I came away as Mr. Reg Filkey and Mr. Roscoe Pursley  
were there doing the work. They have never reported to me  
in regard to the nature of the work.

However, after running casing and perforating there was a heavy  
flow of water and many months later Mr. Jeoffroy stated that  
he had requested permission of your Commission to convert the  
well into a water well for ranch use as it was cased, and the  
casing still remains in the well on which Mr. Jeoffroy welded  
a cap pending the conversion.

I assumed that Mr. Pursley had followed the necessary procedure  
in converting the well by filing the proper forms with you along  
with the written request for the conversion by Mr. Jeoffroy.

I am forwarding your letter to Mr. Reg Filkey Jr., Hawkinson Tire  
Tread Co., Market at Theresa, St. Louis, Missouri as he repre-  
sented the St. Louis interests in the operation.

I do not know the present whereabouts of Mr. Pursley but I am  
sure your letter will reach him. And in the event that I can be  
of service to the operators of this well in way of filing such  
forms and reports as are required under your regulations I shall  
be happy to do so if Mr. Filkey and Mr. Pursley will contact me  
which they have not done since they left New Mexico except on  
on occasion when I called Mr. Pursley in regard to the New Mexico  
operation.

If I can be of service to you in any way I shall appreciate the  
opportunity.

Enclosed is a letter from the Special Assistant to the Attorney General of New Mexico associated with the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, which is self-explanatory.

After leaving New Mexico I never learned the extent of your work on the Jeoffroy well nor your future plans relating to the well although Mr. Jeoffroy told me many months later that he had requested permission to convert the well to water use on his ranch. But to do this requires certain forms to be filed with the Commission as set forth in the Rules and Regulations supplied by the Commission.

This matter is urgent and should be attended to at once; and if I can be of service to you and Roscoe in complying with the regulations I shall do so.

Should Roscoe be in Denver at any time he might call me as I have never heard from him since he left New Mexico except on the one occasion that I called him relative to the Jeoffroy well. His plans seemed to me rather indefinite at the time and I have never heard from him or you either since operations ceased on the well.

Should you and Roscoe would want me to assist you in regard to preparing the proper reports I would suggest that you prepare a detailed statement of the work done on the well, amount of casing run, size and weight which will be listed in the invoices, and a written request from the present owners of the land for permission to use the well for ranch purposes can be acquired then special forms from the Commission covering the conversion will be necessary. Kindly advise.
