A plugging bond is being forwarded to your office for your approval covering the captioned well.

Due to unavoidable circumstances, weather in New Mexico and work here I have been unable to proceed with the New Mexico work until now.

I wish to reopen the Rinehart No. 2 well as I have suggested in previous correspondence and bring that well into production which I firmly believe I shall be able to do.

There will be no divided command there now and I can work as I would like to do and having full charge I believe that my plan will bring the Mora County section of the Raton Basin into production.

Just recently I had the pleasure of making a well location here in Weld County, Colorado only 400' from a Pure Oil dry hole, and my location has come into production so I have been informed which is not so bad in a wildcat area.

The majors believe that the Raton Basin will prove highly productive when the key to that geology has been found and after spending ninety days in the field there prior to drilling I believe that I can show production there.

The Cullen & Hunt interests have some excellent geology there but they will not make a move until some small operator opens a field then the fire will start and the only way I can hold my own is to outguess them on geology and get inside the door ahead of major operators. I shall try.

Kindly advise me at your earliest convenience as to your action on this matter.
