



This is to certify that this plat is a true and accurate representation of the Continental Oil Company's Leatherwood Read No. 1 oilwell location 2080 ft. from North line and 1890 ft. from East line of Section 15, T.16N., R.17E. The stones representing section corners were set by the San Miguel County Surveyor in 1905 when he subdivided the Las Vegas Grant. They are accepted corners by the present land owners. The ground elevation of 6740 feet above sea level is referenced to a U.S.C. & G.S. benchmark at the A.T. & S.F. depot in Las Vegas, New Mexico.
