- 2 EXAMINER DAWSON: Good morning, ladies and
- 3 gentlemen. Today is Thursday, May 2nd. We're here at
- 4 the Wendell Chino Building, 1220 South Saint Francis,
- 5 for OCD Docket 15-19.
- 6 I'm Scott Dawson, your examiner today. And
- 7 to my right is David Brooks. He's our attorney today.
- 8 We also have Marlene Salvidrez and Marilyn Gruebel here.
- 9 She's with the OCD, and Marilyn has her own business --
- DR. GRUEBEL: Reporting businesses.
- 11 EXAMINER DAWSON: -- reporting business.
- 12 We'll go over the docket at this time. I'm
- 13 going to start at the very last part of the docket here
- 14 and just go over Cases 20476, 20477 and 20478. These
- 15 are all EOG Resources for compulsory pooling. And these
- 16 are also, I believe, associated with Case Numbers 20283
- and 20284, which is Cimarex Energy Company for
- 18 compulsory pooling. These cases are continued, I am
- 19 assuming.
- 20 And I think, Mr. Bruce, you had requested a
- 21 continuance to May 16th?
- 22 MR. BRUCE: That's when the Cimarex cases
- 23 are scheduled for.
- 24 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. And EOG, Holland &
- 25 Hart, are you guys okay with the 16th on that one or --

1 the problem with the 16th is that we're not sure if that

- 2 can be heard because on the 17th, we have a special
- 3 hearing. So would you guys rather continue that to a
- 4 further date down the road, or what's your thoughts on
- 5 that one, Mr. Feldewert?
- 6 MR. FELDEWERT: My understanding, subject
- 7 to Mr. Bruce, is that these cases will be continued to
- 8 May 16th and then we would try to find a docket to hear
- 9 them together because I only saw the emails. So I'm
- 10 like you, not optimistic we'll be able to hear them on
- 11 the 16th.
- 12 EXAMINER DAWSON: If we cannot hear them on
- 13 the 16th, then on the 16th, we'll continue them further
- 14 down --
- 15 MR. FELDEWERT: Maybe work on getting a
- 16 date at that time?
- 17 EXAMINER DAWSON: Yes, a further date, an
- 18 undetermined date.
- Okay. Thank you.
- 20 So going back to the top of the list,
- 21 20411 -- Case Number 20411 is continued. 20412 is
- 22 continued. 20413, 20414 and 20415 are continued.
- 23 20420, 20421, 20422 and 20423 are continued. 20441,
- 24 20442, 20443, 20444, 20445, 20446, they're all
- 25 continued. 20447 is readvertised and will be continued.

1 20451 is continued. 20452 and 20453 are both dismissed.

- 2 20410 is dismissed. 20161, they have withdrawn the
- 3 amendment.
- 4 20456 through 20465 are all continued.
- 5 That's 20456, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64 and 65.
- 6 20469 is dismissed. 20470 is continued.
- 7 20480 is dismissed. 20472, 20473, 20474 are all
- 8 continued. 16504 is continued. 20475 is continued.
- 9 And that should take care of all the
- 10 dismissals and continuances.
- If any of you have any further continuances
- 12 and dismissals, can you please let me know at this
- 13 time --
- MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, on page 2 near
- 15 the top, WPX, 20450, that's kind of a companion case
- 16 with the following -- with the following WPX case and
- 17 also some Matador cases. The second one is continued to
- 18 May 30th, and the first one, the Beagle well, should be
- 19 continued to May 30th.
- 20 And Ms. Shaheen represents WPX.
- 21 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. You said just that
- 22 one case, 20450?
- MR. BRUCE: Correct.
- 24 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. So Case 20450 will
- 25 be continued.

Page 5 Any others that anybody else has? 1 2 MS. SHAHEEN: On page 2, Case Number 20161, Devon Lone Tree Draw, where it says "Withdrawn 3 Amendment" --4 5 EXAMINER DAWSON: Yes. MS.
