For the purposes of this hearing, Parties shall adhere to the following special rules:

1. **All parties must submit any potential exhibits to Commission Clerk, Florene Davidson, in digital format by 12:00 p.m. on June 15, 2020 so that the exhibits may be provided to each of the Commissioners prior to the meeting.**
2. All party attorneys must remain connected to the hearing at all times. The absence of a party attorney will force the Chair to immediately recess the hearing until such time as the

attorney rejoins the meeting. Any significant delay in the hearing due to a failed connection or other cause of absence will result in a continuance of the hearing.

3. All witnesses must be available on the hearing program when called. Should the witness exclusion rule be invoked, attorneys should ensure that all potential witnesses be available until the completion of their testimony. Any witness that may be recalled by an attorney must continue to remain available throughout the hearing. Any witnesses failed connection or other cause of absence will result in a continuance of the hearing.
4. Should any connection problem occur during the meeting which prohibits public attendance or attendance of any Commissioner, party, attorney, or witness, the meeting will be immediately recessed and the Chair will determine if the meeting can continue with full public access. Should public access be impeded, the hearing will be continued.
5. Parties unable to adhere to these rules or any other Commission rules for adjudications due to the telephonic/virtual format of this hearing or any other reason related to the current public health emergency should request a continuance of this hearing as soon as possible.
