- 2 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: I'll call case 21072.
- 3 The Applicant is Colgate Operating. This is a compulsory
- 4 pooling application for a well named Red Bandana.
- 5 Applicant's counsel is Modrall, Sperling.
- And, by the way, this is Cases 21072,
- 7 21074, 21075, and 21092. All of those first four cases
- 8 relate to the well named Red Bandana.
- 9 Who is here from Modrall, Sperling? Is
- 10 that you, Mr. Hough?
- 11 MR. HOUGH: Yes that's correct, Madam Examiner.
- 12 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. We have a
- 13 number of other parties in the matter.
- 14 Ms. Shaheen, are you here for Magnum
- 15 Hunter?
- 16 MS. SHAHEEN: Good morning, Madam Examiner. I
- 17 am here for Magnum Hunter.
- 18 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Mr. Bruce, are you here
- 19 for Mewbourne and Chai Energy?
- 20 (Note: No response.)
- 21 Mr. Bruce?
- I want to get the folks calling in.
- MR. BRUCE: Can you hear me?
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yes, I can hear you.
- 25 MR. BRUCE: Okay. Yes, I am here for Mewbourne

- 1 and Chai.
- 2 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. You appear
- 3 to be Call-in 5.
- 4 Let's see. Now we have MRC Delaware and
- 5 EOG.
- Is that you, Mr. Feldewert?
- 7 MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, Madam Examiner. Good
- 8 morning.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Good morning.
- 10 And finally we have Yates Energy and
- 11 Jalapeno. Who is here from the Gallegos firm?
- 12 (Note: No response.)
- 13 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: I have unmuted all of
- 14 the folks calling in on the phone. Is there anyone here
- 15 for Yates Energy and Jalapeno?
- 16 (Note: No response.)
- 17 All right. Well, we are down for a status
- 18 conference this morning. Let's proceed.
- 19 Mr. Hough, would you like to start?
- 20 MR. HOUGH: Good morning. That's correct, Madam
- 21 Examiner. The bottom line is, you know, the parties have
- 22 spoken, and Mr. Chairman, you know, this is something that
- 23 should be set for a contested docket in the fall that we
- 24 had talked about.
- 25 I know Mr. Bruce had submitted the Request

1 for Status Conference just laying that out, so as far as

- 2 he is concerned at the time we're prepared to proceed with
- 3 a hearing.
- 4 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. And we're
- 5 now into November before we're setting matters for
- 6 contested hearings. Do you have an estimate as to how
- 7 long the hearing will take?
- 8 MR. BRUCE: Madam Chair, this is Jim Bruce.
- 9 I'm guessing it will have to be a full day.
- 10 Lance, would you agree?
- MR. HOUGH: Yeah, I would agree in light of all
- 12 the parties involved here -- you know, obviously
- 13 resolutions can be reached in the meantime, but given all
- 14 the parties I think a full day would be appropriate.
- 15 MR. BRUCE: And, Madam Chair, cases also in on
- 16 this status conference are Cases 15 through 18 under the
- 17 docket, which are Mewbourne Oil Company counter
- 18 applications.
- 19 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. So that would be
- 20 Cases 21325, 21326, 21327 and 21328, Mewbourne Oil.
- MR. BRUCE: That's correct.
- 22 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. Mewbourne Oil is
- 23 the Applicant, compulsory pooling applications, and the
- 24 well name is Hemingway.
- 25 All right. So the next full day -- I've

1 just recently scheduled something for November 19th but

- 2 the 20th, which is the Friday after the 19th, is
- 3 available. And what we might do is, I guess based on our
- 4 observation that a number of these contested hearings
- 5 settle, we may well want to set it on the 19th with the
- 6 understanding that if in fact the other matter which is
- 7 already set for the 19th actually goes, it wouldn't occur
- 8 till the 20th.
- 9 Does that make sense?
- 10 MR. BRUCE: It makes sense to me.
- MR. HOUGH: So, Madam Examiner, the bottom line
- is we'll set it for the 19th, and then, you know, we as
- 13 the parties should reserve the 20th in the event it gets
- 14 pushed into that day. Is that correct?
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yes, that's what I was
- 16 trying to say, yes.
- MR. HOUGH: No, that's what you said. I just
- 18 wanted to make sure my understanding was correct.
- 19 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yeah.
- 20 Okay. Let's see. All right. So if you
- 21 would please submit a draft Prehearing Order setting it on
- 22 the 19th, continuing onto the 20th, as necessary, and I'll
- 23 sign that when you submit it.
- MR. HOUGH: Thank you.
- MR. BRUCE: Thank you.
