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Page 3 1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move then to a rather large set of cases, there are 15 of them that I will 2 3 call, which are all part of the same status conference. We 4 have 20840, 20841 and 20842. Marathon Oil is the applicant in each of those three cases, compulsory pooling 5 6 applications related to a well named Shake-N-Bake. 7 Then I'm just going to call all the cases at 8 once, and then I will ask for appearances. Then 20843, 9 20844, and 20848, Marathon Oil the applicant, compulsory 10 pooling applications. Those three cases relate to a well named Cerberus 3. 11 12 And then in 20845, 20846 and 20847, Marathon Oil 13 is the applicant, compulsory pooling applications related to 14 a well named Trojan Horse. 15 21383, 21384, 21385 and 21386, Matador Production is the applicant, compulsory pooling applications relating 16 to a well named Warrior. 17 And finally, 21436, and 21437, Matador Production 18 is the applicant, compulsory pooling applications related to 19 a well named Gladiator. So we have Modrall Sperling on 20 behalf of Marathon Oil. Is that you, Ms. Bennett? 21 22 MS. BENNETT: Good morning, Madam Examiner. Ιt is Deana Bennett on behalf of Marathon Oil Permian LLC. 23 24 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Ms. Bennett. 25 And then we have appearances by Foran Oil. Let's see.

Page 4 Mr. Moellenberg, are you here for Foran? I saw Mr. 1 2 Moellenberg earlier. 3 MR. MOELLENBERG: Let me try again and get the 4 right mute button. Can you hear me now? 5 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: I can hear you. 6 MR. MOELLENBERG: Very good. Dal Moellenberg of 7 Gallagher and Kennedy for Foran Oil Company. 8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. And then we we have MRC Explorers, MRC Spiral and MRC Delaware. Who 9 here is from Holland & Hart for the MRCs? 10 MR. FELDEWERT: Michael Feldewert with the 11 12 Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart here on behalf of the MRC 13 entities, which would be Matador Production. 14 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. And is there 15 anyone else entering an appearance this morning? (No audible response.) 16 17 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: I hear nothing. All right. So we are down for a status conference. Ms. 18 Bennett, would you like to kick off the discussion? 19 MS. BENNETT: Certainly. Thank you, Madam 20 Examiner. These cases are competing cases, and there has 21 been a number of iterations of the applications, and we have 22 23 had several different hearing dates set. And, most 24 recently, as you recall, a hearing date was set for 25 yesterday through tomorrow.

7 And Mr. Feldewert can correct me if I'm wrong 8 here, but our preliminary discussions yesterday were to 9 request a status conference in January 2021 to allow the 10 parties additional time to negotiate and be able to come 11 back to the Division in 2021 with some further information.

Mr. Feldewert, feel free to add to that as yousee fit.

14 MR. FELDEWERT: That's correct. I think, you 15 know, you will see from the filings that there has been some gyrations to get Matador substituted as -- for Ridge Runner, 16 17 a number of these applications that has now been accomplished with the prehearing order, I think we have been 18 able to sort out the cases so we can all keep them straight 19 in the prehearing order and what cases are related and 20 what -- in terms of what acreage is involved. 21

But Ms. Bennett is right. My understanding in speaking with Matador is that since they are now in a position that used to be held with Ridge Runner, that they have been able to have some productive discussions with

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Page 6 Marathon, they are hopeful that an agreement can be reached. 1 2 Everybody recognizes that we have the holidays coming up here in November and December, and so we thought 3 4 it would be -- the most prudent thing to do would be to move 5 this case for a status conference in January. Hopefully by 6 that time we can have a positive report, if not before. If 7 not, at that time we can schedule a hearing for sometime 8 next year. 9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you. 10 Anything to to add, Mr. Moellenberg? MR. MOELLENBERG: Thanks, Madam Hearing Officer. 11 12 I have nothing to add to that. That's all fine. 13 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you. 14 So the two regular docket dates in January are January 7 and 15 January 21. Which of those dockets would you like to be on for another status conference? 16 17 MR. FELDEWERT: I would suggest January 7. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. I don't hear 18 19 any, any objection. Ms. Bennett? 20 MS. BENNETT: That's fine. Thank you. 21 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay, thank you. Thank you all very much, and we will add your matter on January 7 22 23 for a status conference. Thank you. 2.4 (Concluded.) 25
