- 2 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: All right. Moving
- 3 on to Agenda item No. 4, Approval of the Scheduling Order
- 4 in Case No. 21528: Application of the New Mexico Oil
- 5 Conservation Division to consider proposed rules to
- 6 regulate the venting and flaring of natural gas for oil
- 7 and natural production and gathering facilities.
- Before we do an approval of this, I would
- 9 like to just open it up to parties who have entered
- 10 appearances on this, and see if they have any brief
- 11 statements regarding the scheduling order.
- 12 I will start with the Oil Conservation
- 13 Division.
- Mr. Ames, do you have any statements
- 15 regarding the scheduling order?
- 16 MR. AMES: Madam Chair, members of the
- 17 commission, good morning. My name is Eric Ames, counsel
- 18 with the Office of General Counsel, Energy, Minerals and
- 19 Natural Resources Department, on behalf of OCD.
- 20 The Scheduling Order reflects OCD's
- 21 understanding of the agreement reached between the parties
- 22 following the Commission's last meeting. Thank you.
- 23 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Thank you, Mr. Ames.
- 24 Mr. Feldewert, do you have anything to say
- on the scheduling order?

1 MR. FELDEWERT: No, Madam Chairman. I am

- 2 (inaudible)
- 3 (Note: Reporter interruption.)
- 4 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Mr. Feldewert, you
- 5 may want to turn your video off and try again.
- 6 MR. FELDEWERT: Can you hear me better now?
- 7 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Yeah, that's better.
- 8 MR. FELDEWERT: I apologize. On behalf of New
- 9 Mexico Oil and Gas Association I don't have any other
- 10 comments on the Scheduling Order. I think we -- from just
- 11 the format of what's happening today, I think a two-week
- 12 hearing like this is going to be a challenge, but we'll
- 13 give it a shot.
- 14 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Thank you, Mr.
- 15 Feldewert.
- 16 Ms. Fox, do you have any statements
- 17 regarding the Scheduling Order?
- MS. FOX: No, I don't. And I'd like to thank
- 19 counsel and counsel for the Commission for working through
- 20 some issues we initially had with the original Amended
- 21 Order. We really appreciate everybody's efforts in that
- 22 regard to get to a Procedural Order we all agree with.
- 23 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Thank you, Ms. Fox.
- 24 Commissioners, do you -- have you reviewed
- 25 the Order and do you have any questions, changes, et

- 1 cetera, on it?
- 2 COMMISSIONER ENGLER: This is Tom Engler. I
- 3 have reviewed the Order. I have no questions.
- 4 COMMISSIONER KESSLER: Commission Chair, I have
- 5 also reviewed the Order and believe that it accurately
- 6 reflects what we have (inaudible).
- 7 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Okay. Is there a
- 8 motion to adopt the Scheduling Order?
- 9 COMMISSIONER ENGLER: This is Tom Engler. I
- 10 move to adopt the Scheduling Order.
- 11 THE SPECIAL MASTER: Is there a second?
- 12 COMMISSIONER KESSLER: I second.
- 13 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Mr. Moander, would
- 14 you do a roll call vote.
- MR. MOANDER: Yes.
- 16 Chair Sandoval.
- 17 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Approved.
- 18 MR. MOANDER: Member Engler.
- 19 COMMISSIONER ENGLER: Approved.
- MR. MOANDER: Member Kessler.
- 21 COMMISSIONER KESSLER: Approved.
- MR. MOANDER: The Motion passes unanimously.
- MR. FELDEWERT: Madam Chair, this is Michael
- 24 Feldewert. We have one, I guess, question.
- 25 I just saw that in the file there is an

1 Amended Procedural Order that was issued on November 19th.

- 2 Is that what we're talking about today?
- 3 MR. MOANDER: This is Chris Moander, Counsel.
- I had this question asked by another party,
- 5 and yes, that's correct. It's the Amended -- the last
- 6 version that everybody saw.
- 7 MR. FELDEWERT: Okay. And I believe it's in the
- 8 file AS R21540-A.
- 9 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Correct.
- 10 MR. FELDEWERT: Okay. Thank you.
- 11 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: I believe it's
- 12 also -- I just pulled it up, and it's posted on OCD's
- 13 website under the Outreach and Public Engagement tab.
- 14 All right.
- MS. FOX: Madam Chair?
- Madam Chair, I'm sorry. I night just note
- 17 to you all, you probably know this, but the email
- 18 address -- for Ms. Davidson two email addresses are given,
- 19 and her personal email address works but when I filed
- 20 another Entry of Appearance this week the OCC email still
- 21 did not work. So I'd just like to note that because it is
- 22 in the Procedural Order I'm worried that people are going
- 23 to be using that email address to submit public comment,
- 24 and, you know, may be only using that one and not the
- 25 personal email. And so maybe I think it would be good if

- 1 that were a working email.
- 2 That's all.
- 3 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Okay. We can look
- 4 into that. I don't think we were aware that there were
- 5 issues with the email. Thank you for bringing that up.
- 6 MS. FOX: Madam Chair, I filed a pleading this
- 7 week and got a bounce back on that email address, as I
- 8 have previously when I have filed pleadings.
- 9 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Okay. Good to know.
- 10 Thank you.
- MR. MOANDER: Madam Chair, may I ask Ms. Fox to
- 12 clarify which address she was sending email to for the
- 13 OCC?
- MS. FOX: Well, both the addresses that are in
- 15 the Procedural Order. Florene.davidson@state.nm.us, that
- works; and occ.hearings@state.nm.us.
- 17 And I had a discussion with Ms. Davidson
- 18 about this before my first filing of an Entry of
- 19 Appearance, and she had noted that occ.hearings email
- 20 address may not work. And it still has not.
- 21 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Okay. We can check
- 22 in with our I.T. I don't think I was aware of that, at
- 23 least, so we will make sure to get that working. Thank
- 24 you for bringing that up.
- 25 MR. AMES: Ms. Sandoval, I want to clarify one

1 thing: The legal notice uses Ms. Davidson's state email

- 2 address throughout. So I believe the legal notice is
- 3 fine. I think the Scheduling Order may need to be
- 4 adjusted.
- 5 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Mr. Moander, what
- 6 would be the process if we just approved that?
- 7 MR. MOANDER: That -- I suppose there could be a
- 8 delegation to you to sign off on a Second Amended version
- 9 in this instance. I think that would be acceptable since
- 10 this is going to be a scrivener's issue rather than a
- 11 substantive change -- unless someone disagrees with that.
- 12 I mean, I'd be willing to hear a counter position.
- So in that instance, we could do that.
- 14 Otherwise we end up having to go back
- 15 through this again and botching the hearing, which I
- 16 absolutely want to avoid almost at any cost to be able to
- 17 get this done.
- 18 So I think that's acceptable if the
- 19 Commission will designate to you the ability to approve
- 20 the Order modified to -- or delete or remove any reference
- 21 to the OCC Hearings Order -- or remove that reference
- 22 within the Order.
- I think that should be sound.
- 24 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: We have another
- 25 email address, as well. It's ocd.hearings, and I know

- 1 that that one is currently working. So it may be
- 2 either -- we either, 1, need to get the OCC working; 2,
- 3 just delete it out of there; or 3, the reference to
- 4 ocdhearings.
- 5 Because what I would like to avoid is the
- 6 State inboxes have very little space in them, and I'm
- 7 afraid that Ms. Davidson's inbox is going to explode
- 8 potentially with all the comments. So we were trying to
- 9 get them into a place that won't have problems.
- 10 MR. MOANDER: Okay. So just to clarify, the
- 11 Commission will want to substitute -- or I guess it would
- 12 be Chair Sandoval. You want to substitute
- ocd.hearings@state.nm.us for occ.hearings@state.nm.us.
- 14 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: I think -- I mean I
- 15 would prefer to try to get it working and not hassle the
- 16 Scheduling Order. Is there a way to give -- to delegate,
- 17 I guess me, authority to just make either one of those
- 18 changes. Either -- or maybe, you know, no change at all
- 19 if we get it working, or to delete it, or modify it.
- 20 Can we make it that broad so that we can
- 21 make that change?
- 22 MR. MOANDER: The issue here is the hearing
- 23 date, you've got that set. And we are sort of under a 30-
- 24 -- well, I think we're under -- yeah, we're under the 30
- 25 days here. So since it's not substantive -- you know,

1 what I wouldn't advise is to let this linger, and the

- 2 concern would be if there's going to be a bunch of I.T.
- 3 efforts to try to get this inbox open or working, how long
- 4 is that going to take versus either deletion or inserting
- 5 a known, workable email address.
- I think that's the issue. And if there's a
- 7 timing matter, it would seem to be more prudent to just do
- 8 a substitution or a deletion.
- 9 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Okay. That's fine.
- 10 Let's just do either a substitution or deletion.
- 11 MR. MOANDER: The issue, then, is that --
- MS. MALAVE: There's --
- MR. MOANDER: Was that Sally?
- MS. MALAVE: Yes. I was going to say there
- 15 really isn't any need for additional discussion at this
- 16 point. You're going to allow Commissioner Kessler
- 17 delegate the authority to make the modifications that are
- 18 necessary to ensure that the public has the ability to
- 19 file pleadings, whether it's Florene's or any other email.
- 20 I would note that the public notice says
- 21 Florene Davidson's email only, and so I would -- at this
- 22 point in time I would say stick with that and possibly
- 23 have I.T. deal with, you know, moving things. You know,
- 24 monitoring that email for purposes of ensuring that
- 25 there's space.

- 1 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Okay.
- 2 COMMISSIONER KESSLER: I make a motion
- 3 authorizing Director Sandoval to make the appropriate
- 4 changes, as discussed, and modify the Order to correct or
- 5 eliminate, as appropriate, the email address.
- 6 COMMISSIONER ENGLER: This is Tom Engler. I
- 7 second Commissioner Kessler's motion.
- 8 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Mr. Moander, would
- 9 you do a roll call vote, please.
- 10 MR. MOANDER: Yes.
- 11 Chair Sandoval.
- 12 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: I approve.
- MR. MOANDER: Commissioner Engler:
- 14 COMMISSIONER ENGLER: Approved.
- MR. MOANDER: Member Kessler?
- 16 COMMISSIONER KESSLER: Approved.
- 17 MR. MOANDER: The motion to grant the Chair
- 18 authority to make necessary modifications to the
- 19 Scheduling Order so the public can comment, as well as
- 20 pleadings can be properly filed, is passed unanimously.
- 21 Just so -- for the sake of clarity on this,
- 22 I will get on this as soon as the hearing's over so we get
- 23 this done. So we'll get this done today.
- 24 COMMISSION CHAIR SANDOVAL: Okay. Thank you.
