- 2 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move, then, to the
- 3 next matter: 21063, 21064, 21065, and then also 20988 and
- 4 20989. Matador Production is the Applicant in the first
- 5 three matters, Ostrich Oil is the applicant in the second
- 6 two, and these are compulsory pooling applications. They
- 7 are competing. The well names are Nina Cortell and
- 8 Frizzle.
- 9 Mr. Bruce.
- 10 MR. BRUCE: Yes. Uhm, first of all I'd note
- 11 that these cases have been pending for a little while, as
- 12 you can see by the Matador case numbers, and they would
- 13 like to have them heard as soon as possible. But the
- 14 second thing is Matador understood that Ostrich -- yeah,
- 15 that Ostrich may be withdrawing their cases.
- 16 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Let me ask
- 17 for the other lawyers who have entered appearances.
- 18 Let's see. We have Mr. Padilla for
- 19 Ostrich.
- MR. PADILLA: Yes.
- 21 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay.
- 22 MR. PADILLA: Uhm, I -- Ostrich does not want to
- 23 withdraw its applications at this time, but they do
- 24 consider the current oil and gas climate as being not good
- 25 for drilling, especially in this area. But they don't

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1 want to withdraw the application; they don't want to be

- 2 force pooled.
- 3 So at this point I have nothing else to say
- 4 other than that they want to proceed.
- 5 So if those February dates are fine, we
- 6 will accept those.
- 7 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. And then I
- 8 saw an entry of appearance on behalf of Conoco Phillips by
- 9 Holland & Hart.
- 10 MS. LUCK: That's correct. Good morning, Madam
- 11 Examiner. Kaitlyn Luck with the Santa Fe office of
- 12 Holland and Hart on behalf of Conoco Phillips.
- 13 Conoco Phillips is simply entering an
- 14 appearance to preserve its rights as a pooled party, and
- is fine with whatever dates work for MRC and Ostrich.
- 16 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you,
- 17 Ms. Luck.
- 18 Were there any other appearances in any of
- 19 these five matters, 21063 through 65 and then 20988 and
- 20 89. (Note: No response.)
- So, Mr. Bruce, how would feel about a
- 22 hearing on one of the February dates. We have February
- 4th and 5th or February 18th and 19th.
- MR. BRUCE: Well, the earlier the better.
- 25 I would add that if the parties do come to

Page 5 terms fairly soon, I would ask that the matter be placed 1 2 on, you know, one of the regular hearing dockets this 3 year, or have that option, anyway. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Right. So if you get 4 5 to the point where it can be presented by affidavit, as I understand it, it can be moved up. In the meantime, now 6 if you would please prepare a Prehearing Order, and I'll sign it and we will get you on the schedule for a 8 contested hearing on February 4th, to follow the one that 9 was just set in Catena Resources. 10 11 MR.
