- 2 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move, then, to the
- 3 next status conference. This is Matter 21418. Mewbourne
- 4 Oil is the applicant. It's a application for unit
- 5 expansion.
- 6 Mr. Bruce.
- 7 MR. BRUCE: Yes, I'm here for Mewbourne.
- 8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you.
- 9 We have a number of other appearances in this matter.
- 10 We have Modrall Sperling on behalf of
- 11 Apache.
- 12 MR. HOUGH: That's correct, Madam Examiner.
- 13 Lance Hough on behalf of Apache Corporation, as well as
- 14 Cimarex Energy Co.
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Oh, thank you very
- 16 much.
- 17 And then Marathon?
- MS. BENNETT: Good morning, Madam Examiner.
- 19 This is Deana Bennett on behalf of Marathon Oil Permian,
- 20 LLC.
- 21 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Then Devon.
- 22 MR. RANKIN: Good morning, Madam Examiner. Adam
- 23 Rankin appearing on behalf of Devon Energy, as well as
- 24 COG, Chevron, and Chisholm.
- 25 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. Terrific. Thank

- 1 you.
- 2 Let me pause for a moment to see if there
- 3 are any other entries.
- 4 Hearing none, if you would, please, Mr.
- 5 Bruce, kick off the discussion.
- 6 MR. BRUCE: This is simply a voluntary unit.
- 7 Nobody can be forced into it. Chisolm has objected and
- 8 doesn't want it done by affidavit, but this is the type of
- 9 case that even if it was live it would take about 20
- 10 minutes to put on. So this is not a big deal, because
- 11 none of the parties can be forced into it.
- 12 And I guess there's two factors to
- 13 consider. None of them can be forced into it.
- 14 I understood that COG wanted to retain the
- 15 right to develop its own acreage. Well, if it still had
- 16 that option it might have to deal with Mewbourne or some
- 17 other interest owners, but it still has that option,
- 18 No. 1.
- 19 And No. 2, if enough of the interest owners
- 20 don't voluntarily join in the well, the State Land Office
- 21 won't approve the unit. So I just see no point in
- 22 continuing this a long time, because there's nothing to
- 23 it.
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you.
- I think we could identify a date, then,

1 before February, if it will be short, as you described.

- 2 Are there comments from any of the other
- 3 counsel?
- 4 MR. RANKIN: Good morning, Madam Hearing
- 5 Officer.
- 6 Not at this time. I think the parties are
- 7 in discussion. As Mr. Bruce has pointed out it is a
- 8 voluntary unit, meaning that individuals who do not wish
- 9 to participate cannot be required to do so, and so in our
- 10 case we are continuing to discuss with the applicant in
- 11 this case, trying to resolve any concerns about inclusion
- 12 of their acreage
- 13 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. Thank you,
- 14 Mr. Rankin. Anyone else? No?
- 15 MR. HOUGH: Not Apache. I'm sorry. Cimarex,
- 16 not EOG. That's all.
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Hough.
- 18 Mr. Bruce, I'm looking at the calendar, and
- 19 it seems to me we have an awful lot of special hearings
- 20 set at the moment in connection with November 19th.
- 21 November 5th is much lighter, and December 3rd is light at
- 22 this moment in terms of having special hearings set.
- MR. BRUCE: December 3rd?
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yes.
- 25 MR. BRUCE: That would be okay with me

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1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. If you would
2 then please prepare a Prehearing Order for December 3rd,
3 and we'll put it on that docket.
4 MR. BRUCE: Okay. Thank you very much.
5 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you.
