1 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: We will move on to 3

- on the spreadsheet, 21100, Marathon Oil. And I believe the
- 3 attorneys are from Modrall Sperling.
- 4 MS. BENNETT: (Inaudible.)
- 5 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: I see lips moving,
- 6 Deana, but no sound.
- 7 MS. BENNETT: (Inaudible.)
- 8 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: We can hear you.
- 9 Thank you.
- 10 MS. BENNETT: Okay, great. I was double muted,
- 11 so I was being extra careful to mute in two different
- 12 places, so I apologize for that.
- 13 Good morning. This is Deana Bennett on behalf of
- 14 Marathon Oil Permian LLC, and I would like to throw myself
- 15 on the mercy of OCD this morning and ask that I be allowed
- 16 to file a late continuance for this case, 21100.
- 17 The Blue Ridge case, 21100, is part of a larger
- 18 set of cases. There are five or six total cases that
- 19 compete with COG cases, and I had intended to file the
- 20 motion for continuance for all of the cases, but I
- 21 overlooked this one.
- 22 And I have confirmed with COG's counsel that the
- 23 intent was for all of these cases, the Blue Ridge cases and
- 24 the competing cases to all be continued. So at this time I
- 25 would like to request that I be allowed to file a late

- 1 continuance for Case Number 21100.
- 2 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Did you file anything
- 3 in writing, or are you just doing this verbally?
- 4 MS. BENNETT: I did e-mail the Division on
- 5 Tuesday as soon as I realized I had omitted this case, and
- 6 was informed that I should raise it today with the examiner,
- 7 and that a decision would be rendered today on whether I
- 8 file a continuance today or not.
- 9 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Sorry. I have the
- 10 double mute problem, too. Anyone here from Holland & Hart
- 11 on this case?
- 12 MS. LUCK: Kaitlyn Luck with the Santa Fe office
- of Holland & Hart, and we are appearing in these cases for
- 14 COG, and it was the agreement of the parties that all of
- 15 these cases would be continued. We understand it was an
- 16 oversight in terms of this one case.
- 17 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. And first give
- 18 me some numbers of the other cases and then tell me when
- 19 they have been continued to.
- 20 MS. BENNETT: The other cases by way of example
- 21 are Marathon case 21101, and it's continued to April 22,
- 22 2021. That's the Blue Ridge case. 21102, 21104, 21105 and
- 23 21106 are the Marathon case numbers that I filed
- 24 continuances for, and those were all continued to April 22,
- 25 2021. I don't have the COG cases in front of me, but those

- 1 were also continued to April 22, 2021.
- MS. LUCK: I can provide those case numbers.
- 3 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Ms. Luck, any
- 4 objection to April 22?
- 5 MS. LUCK: No objection.
- 6 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: All right. Well, we
- 7 will continue this case to April 22, and maybe you can -- I
- 8 assume we have in the record what the other cases are so we
- 9 know what, what will all be heard together at the same time.
- 10 MS. BENNETT: That's right.
- 11 MS. LUCK: Yeah.
- 12 MS. BENNETT: Go ahead, Kaitlyn, or I can fill
- 13 you in. All the continuance motions we filed cross
- 14 reference the parties' cases, so they all -- all of my
- 15 continuance motions cross reference COG's case numbers, and
- 16 all of COG's continuance motions cross reference all of
- 17 Marathon case numbers. And I will today, as soon as the
- 18 hearings are over, I will file a second continuance motion
- 19 through the fee portal to make sure it's formally in the
- 20 case file.
- 21 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Excellent. Okay,
- 22 thank you. So case --
- MS. BENNETT: Thank you very much.
- 24 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: I'm sorry, Ms. Luck?
- MS. LUCK: I was just going to mention the COG
