OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") moves to continue the hearing scheduled in this matter for March 3, 2021, and states the following in support thereof:

- 1. On February 23, 2021, OCD docketed the Notice of Violation ("NOV") issued to Wespac Energy, LLC ("Wespac").
- 2. OCD's Docketing Notice stated that Wespac failed to respond to the NOV, and that the informal resolution period had expired.
- 3. Shortly after OCD served the Docketing Notice, Wespac contacted OCD's counsel, and since then, has taken concrete steps to correct the alleged violations.
- 4. To allow Wespac sufficient time to informally resolve the NOV, OCD moves to continue the hearing until April 21, 2021.

WHEREFORE, OCD respectfully requests that the March 3, 2021 hearing be continued until April 21, 2021, and notice of the new hearing date be published.
