- 1. My name is Brandon Patrick. I work for Novo Oil & Gas Northern Delaware, LLC ("Novo") as a Landman.
- 2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.

- 3. I am familiar with the applications filed by Novo in each of these cases and the status of the development efforts for the pooled spacing units.
- 4. Orders R-21208, R-21209, and R-21210 were issued on April 9, 2020, and pooled three separate spacing units for horizontal wells in certain stratigraphic depths of the <u>Bone Spring formation</u> (Laguna Salado; Bone Spring pool [Pool Code 96721]) underlying Sections 10 and 15, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, in Eddy County as follows:
 - Under Case 21037, the Division entered **Order No. R-21208** creating a standard 160-acre horizontal spacing unit in the First Bone Spring Interval of the Bone Spring formation from a depth of 7,702 feet to 7,839 underlying the W/2 W/2 of Section 15;
 - Under Case 21038, the Division entered **Order No. R-21209** creating a standard 320-acre horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation from a depth of 7,839 feet to the base of the Bone Spring formation underlying the W/2 W/2 of Sections 10 and 15; and
 - Under Case 21039, the Division entered **Order No. R-21210** creating a standard 320-acre horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation from a depth of 7,839 feet to the base of the Bone Spring formation underlying the E/2 W/2 of Sections 10 and 15.
- 5. These three spacing units were created to accommodate and avoid existing Bone Spring development in the W/2 of Sections 10 and 15.
- 6. Under Case 21040, the Division also issued **Order No. R-21211** on April 9, 2020, creating a standard 640-acre horizontal spacing unit in the <u>Wolfcamp formation</u> (Purple Sage-Wolfcamp Gas Pool [98220]) underlying the W/2 of Sections 10 and 15.

- 7. Each of these pooling orders designates Novo as the operator of the Unit and requires drilling of a dedicated well to commence within a year (April 9, 2021). Despite the global COVID pandemic, Novo prepared and submitted to the Bureau of Land Management ("BLM") fourteen (14) applications for permits to drill ("APDs") in early October 2020. The BLM has not yet approved any of those APDs. Novo plans to develop the acreage subject to these pooling orders immediately after the BLM approves the APDs.
- 8. Novo anticipates being able to drill the wells required by Orders R-21208, R-21209, R-21210 and R-21211 within the next year and therefore asks that the deadline to commence drilling under each pooling order be extended for a year to April 9, 2022.
- 9. Novo has provided our outside counsel, Holland and Hart, with a list of the working interest owners that remain subject to each pooling order and instructed them to provide notice of this hearing to these pooled working interest owners.
- 10. None of the working interest owners that remain subject to these pooling orders have been asked at this time to make an election on the applicable wells, or to pay their estimated share of the costs to drill, complete and equip the applicable wells.
