Page 3 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: So let me call the first 1 three matters together as they require a contested hearing, 2 apparently we are doing a status conference this morning for 3 4 them, 21630, 21543 and 21560. 21630 is Matador Production, as is 21543. The 5 well names are Colonel R. Howard and Norris Thornton. 6 7 21560 is Flat Creek Resources, and the well name 8 there is Thirteen Seconds. 9 So, Mr. Feldewert, is that you from Holland & 10 Hart for Matador? MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, Madam Hearing Officer. Good 11 morning, Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of 12 13 Holland & Hart appearing on behalf of Matador Production 14 Company. 15 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Good morning. And Mr. Savage, I believe you are here for Flat Creek Resources? 16 17 MR. SAVAGE: Good morning, Darin Savage here for Flat Creek Resources. 18 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Terrific. Let me pause 19 for a moment in the event there are other appearances. 20 21 (No audible response.) 22 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: No? All right. So are 23 we going to talk about a hearing date, are we going to talk 24 about pre-hearing deadlines? What are we going to talk 25 about this morning?

Page 4 1 MR. FELDEWERT: Madam Hearing Officer, 2 Mr. Lamkin, we really have -- there is four cases that are 3 involved here. The case that was recently filed by Flat 4 Creek, case 21747, 21747, which involves a competing laydown spacing unit in the S/2 of Section 23, 23 South, 27 East. 5 So what we have here is Matador has two 6 7 applications which seek standard spacing units in the 8 Wolfcamp Purple Sage Pool in Section 23, one being in the 9 S/2 and the other being in the N/2. 10 Flat Creek has now filed competing applications for laydown spacing units involving the same acreage. So I 11 12 think last time Mr. Savage and I spoke we were anticipating 13 the hearing perhaps in May or June. I don't have a real 14 preference -- well, let me step back. 15 I guess if I have a preference it's probably June I'm not wedded to that, but we would seek to have all 16 3. 17 four cases set for hearing, a contested hearing, I guess my preference would be June 3. 18 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. 19 Thank you, 20 Mr. Feldewert. Mr. Savage? 21 MR. SAVAGE: Yes, Mr. Feldewert is correct, there are four cases now, and they are competing, and I think in 22 23 the applications and the prehearing statement explains the 24 particular cases and the matter in which we would like to 25 approach them.

Page 5 But I believe Flat Creek would prefer an earlier 1 2 date, but I don't think it's set in stone, either. The May 6 would be, I believe, our preference, but I will check with 3 4 the June 3rd and see if that will work as well. 5 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you. 6 If you would confirm that by e-mail, Mr. Savage, I would be 7 happy to prepare the prehearing order as soon as I have that 8 confirmation with the usual deadlines. Are there any other 9 deadlines that would need to be set in the prehearing order 10 besides the two usual ones? MR. FELDEWERT: I don't think so. So, Madam 11 12 Hearing Examiner, I guess I was unaware, you are preparing 13 the prehearing orders now? HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yeah, it just made more 14 15 sense. I have the template on my computer. MR. FELDEWERT: Okay. Okay, understand. 16 17 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: My son's cat helps me, so -- all right. 18 MR. SAVAGE: One point on the proceeding. 19 So the new case, 21747, that right now is scheduled for April 8. 20 Do I need to do a motion to transfer that new date or does 21 the order pick that up? 22 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let me check with Ms. 23 24 Salvidrez. Marlene, would you do that through the portal, 25 or do I do that through the order?

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Page 6 MS. SALVIDREZ: I can move all the cases myself, 1 2 but I know there is going to be exceptions in the future regarding status conferences, so for now I'm moving them. 3 4 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yeah, so just -- just a heads up, generally. Thank you, Marlene. As I understand 5 6 it, because there's that, you know, you develop patterns as 7 we sort of make our way through these cases, there has been a pattern, not in this case, but there has been a pattern of 8 9 cases sort of being set for a status conference hearing and then all of a sudden it's another status conference and then 10 another one, and it just seemed like an elaborate way of 11 12 doing continuances instead of actually having the hearing. 13 So as I understand it, in the future there may be 14 an announcement that, after the first status conference and the first hearing setting, they may be treated more like 15 continuances if in fact we don't go to hearing that first 16 time. 17 18 MR. SAVAGE: I will do it either way, so whatever 19 you quys are --HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Yes, again, 20 this morning that's just a heads-up. Okay. Thank you both, 21 gentlemen. And I will wait for your e-mail confirmation, 22 23 Mr. Savage. Thank you, Mr. Feldewert. We will look at June 24 3. 25 (Concluded.)
