- 2 matters, 21681 and 21682. Matador Production is the
- 3 applicant, these are applications to amend orders. Well
- 4 names are Uncle Ches or Ches. Mr. Feldewert, you are here
- 5 from Holland & Hart?
- 6 MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, Madam Hearing Officer and
- 7 Examiner Lamkin, appearing on behalf of the applicant.
- 8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let me pause for a
- 9 moment. I didn't see entries in the file, in the event
- 10 there are some.
- 11 (No audible response.)
- 12 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: No? You will be
- 13 presenting by affidavit, I take it?
- MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, ma'am.
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Please go ahead.
- 16 MR. FELDEWERT: In these consolidated cases
- 17 Matador Production Company seeks to amend two pooling orders
- 18 that were issued last April for the purpose of allowing
- 19 additional time to commence drilling of the initial
- 20 dedicated wells.
- 21 They involve first Order R-21277 which pools the
- 22 Bone Spring under the Bone Spring formation under the W/2 of
- 23 the W/2 of Sections 16 and 21 in Township 20 South, Range 35
- 24 East.
- 25 The second order is R-21278, which pools the Bone

- 1 Spring formation in the E/2 of the W/2 of the same sections,
- 2 16 and 24. The deadline to commence drilling under the
- 3 current orders is April 28, so next month.
- 4 And as Mr. Prior testifies in his affidavit, an
- 5 extension is sought due to Covid, and then the other
- 6 economic factors that affected drilling and rig availability
- 7 in New Mexico in the past year.
- 8 Mr. Sam Prior's affidavit has been marked as
- 9 Exhibit A in these consolidated cases. He is a land manager
- 10 who previously testified before this Division and he
- 11 testified in the prior cases. He notes that the -- not only
- 12 the reason for the -- for the extension, but that these
- 13 wells are actually now on Matador's drilling schedule, and
- 14 they anticipate that they will commence drilling in, late in
- 15 the second quarter or early third quarter of what is now
- 16 this year in 2021.
- 17 So they seek to extend the drilling deadlines for
- 18 an additional year under the pooling orders to correspond
- 19 with the existing language. So now rather than being April
- 20 28, 2021, it would be April 28, 2022, under each of these
- 21 existing orders.
- 22 He also notes there are three working interest
- 23 owners that remain subject to the pooling orders. None of
- 24 the working interest owners have been asked to make an
- 25 election, nor have they made any payment of their share of

1 the costs to drill and equip these wells, so no one is

- 2 essentially affected at this point.
- 3 And notice was provided to these three working
- 4 interest owners as reflected under our Exhibit B, and they
- 5 have expressed no objection to the extension of this -- of
- 6 the deadline to drill under each of those pooling orders.
- 7 So we ask that this matter and Exhibits A and B
- 8 be admitted in the record, and that this matter be taken
- 9 under advisement and that the Division issue orders
- 10 extending the drilling deadline to April 28, 2022.
- 11 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Feldewert.
- 12 Mr. Lamkin, do you have any questions?
- 13 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LAMKIN: I don't have any
- 14 questions.
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right, thank you. I
- 16 noticed, Mr. Feldewert, it's kind of a bitter sweet
- 17 anniversary today. March 5 of 2020 was the last time we
- 18 were together in Porter Hall, so it's been a whole year.
- 19 MR. FELDEWERT: That was a long time ago.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: So thank you. The
- 21 exhibits are admitted and the matter will be taken under
- 22 advisement.
