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Page 3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: With that I will call 1 Case 21777, Catena Resources. Holland & Hart? 2 3 MS. LUCK: Good morning. Kaitlyn Luck with the 4 Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart on behalf of the applicant in this case, Catena Resources Operating LLC. 5 6 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. And I believe 7 we have an entry from Marathon? 8 MS. BENNETT: Good morning. Deana Bennett on 9 behalf of Marathon Oil Permian LLC. 10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. And Ms. Bennett, are you here in what capacity? Do you object to 11 12 this being taken by affidavit? 13 MS. BENNETT: No, we do not. Thank you for 14 asking. We do not object to the case being taken under 15 consideration by affidavit. I'm just here to protect Marathon's rights -- to preserve our right in case if 16 17 necessary. 18 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Are there any other appearances in this matter, 21777? 19 20 (No audible response.) 21 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Ms. Luck, you may proceed. 22 MS. LUCK: Thank you. In this case Catena 23 24 Resources seeks to amend Order Number R-21230 and because 25 Catena understood there was no opposition to this case

PAUL BACA PROFESSIONAL COURT REPORTERS 500 FOURTH STREET NW - SUITE 105, ALBUQUERQUE, NM 87102 proceeding by affidavit, it filed with the Division its exhibits on Tuesday which include the affidavit of Chris Canon. He is the land consultant of Catena. His affidavit is included in Exhibit B in the packet that was filed with the Division. He has previously testified before the Division and his credentials have been accepted.

His affidavit reflects that the Division order, 7 8 the Division entered Order Number 21230 which created a 280 acre horizontal spacing unit which is comprised of the W/2 9 10 of the NW/4 of Section 33, the W/2 of the W/2 of Section 28 and the SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 21, all in Township 18 11 12 South, Range 35 East in Lea County, New Mexico. This 13 spacing unit was dedicated to the Omega well and will be in 14 the Bone Spring formation.

Mr. Canon's affidavit goes on to explain that due to a change in management at Catena, as well as the economic factors in 2020, drilling this well has been delayed, and so Catena seeks a year extension of the drilling requirement under the order.

20 Under the order the drilling requirement was to 21 drill the well by April 7, and so Catena had filed this 22 application understanding that if the application was filed 23 prior to the drilling extension, the Division would consider 24 it timely.

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And so his affidavit goes on to explain that

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Page 5 Catena is seeking a one-year extension until April 7 of 1 2 2022. And finally he also states that none of the partners have elected or been required to pay their share of well 3 4 costs which supports Catena's request for the drilling extension in this case. 5 Also in the exhibit packet there is an exhibit 6 7 reflecting that notice was provided to the working interest 8 owners who were pooled under the pooling order, and also notice of the hearing was published in the newspaper of 9 10 general circulation where these wells -- excuse me -- where this well is located. So with that I would move the 11 12 admission of Exhibits A through D and request that this case 13 be taken under advisement. 14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Mr. McClure, any questions? 15 TECHNICAL EXAMINER McCLURE: No, Mr. Brancard, I 16 have no questions for this case. 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Any other 18 19 concerns any of the parties? 20 (No audible response.) HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Marathon? 21 22 (No audible response.) 23 MS. BENNETT: No questions. Sorry, I was on 24 mute. 25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Okay.
