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1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Everyone, it is 9:35

- 2 a.m. The hearing of the Oil Conservation Division will
- 3 reconvene.
- 4 Where we left off was Item Number 29. And it's
- 5 Case Number 21795 combined with Case 21796, 21797, 21798,
- 6 Matador Production. Mr. Bruce?
- 7 MR. BRUCE: Yes, I'm here on behalf of Matador.
- 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Excellent. Are there
- 9 any other interested parties in these four cases?
- 10 MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the Examiners,
- 11 Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart
- 12 appearing on behalf of COG Operating LLC, Burlington
- 13 Resources Oil & Gas LP and ConocoPhillips. We do not object
- 14 to the matters proceeding by affidavit.
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Had you
- 16 entered an appearance, or is this your entry of appearance?
- 17 MR. FELDEWERT: No, I'm sorry, Mr. Examiner, we
- 18 had entered -- filed a written entry of appearance.
- 19 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Any other
- 20 interested parties?
- 21 (No audible response.)
- 22 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Mr.
- 23 Bruce, you may proceed.
- MR. BRUCE: Yes, Mr. Examiner, there is one
- 25 exhibit package for all four applications in these matters.

- 1 The first two cases, 795 and 796 collectively seek to pool
- 2 the Bone Spring formation underlying the E/2 of Section 3
- 3 and the E/2 of Section 10 in 22 South, 32 East.
- 4 The second two cases involving the same --
- 5 involve the same land, but concern the Wolfcamp formation.
- 6 Exhibit 1 is the applications and proposed ads.
- 7 Exhibit 2 is my affidavit of notice. I told this
- 8 to Mr. Feldewert earlier that he entered an appearance for
- 9 several companies. Matador informed me the only person who
- 10 needed to be pooled was ConocoPhillips Company so that is
- 11 the only notice I have given.
- 12 I have not received the green card back, but the
- 13 USPS records show on line that they did receive notice, and
- 14 I can supply a copy of that, plus they have entered an
- 15 appearance in this matter, so I think notice is okay.
- 16 The first exhibit -- that was Exhibit B.
- 17 Exhibit C is the landman's affidavit, Robert Helding, one of
- 18 the landman for Matador who has previously testified. The
- 19 exhibit package contains the usual matters, the C-102s, the
- 20 tracts involved in the two applications -- the four
- 21 applications, and then interest ownership breakdown and
- 22 AFEs.
- 23 The exhibit -- that was our Exhibit C.
- 24 Exhibit D is the geologist affidavit which contains the
- 25 usual isopach cross section structure maps of Bone Spring

- 1 and the Wolfcamp.
- 2 And I think the package is complete except --
- 3 uh-oh. The pooling checklists aren't attached, at least in
- 4 my copy. I beg the Division's permission to file them
- 5 immediately after the hearing. My only excuse is I filed
- 6 this exhibit package at about midnight on Tuesday, and I
- 7 probably had a brain malfunction, but if the matter has to
- 8 be continued to hear that, I will do so.
- 9 But with that, I move the admission of Exhibits A
- 10 through D with the provisional acceptance of the pooling
- 11 checklist which I will print out and e-mail over to the
- 12 division.
- 13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Feldewert, do you
- 14 have any questions or concerns?
- MR. FELDEWERT: No, I do not.
- 16 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. McClure?
- 17 TECHNICAL EXAMINER McCLURE: I have no questions
- 18 regarding these cases, Mr. Brancard.
- 19 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So Mr. Bruce, you
- 20 have, I believe, gone through what should be within the
- 21 pooling checklist. You have given us all the contents?
- 22 MR. BRUCE: Yes, I mean the pooling checklist
- 23 basically contains references to, to primarily the C-102s,
- 24 the surface location, first and last take points, the AFEs
- 25 contain the information on total vertical depth, measured

- 1 length of the well, and those -- and all the land
- 2 information. The geological information is submitted at
- 3 this -- has been submitted from which the pooling checklists
- 4 are drafted.
- 5 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. McClure, do you
- 6 have any objections.
- 7 TECHNICAL EXAMINER McCLURE: From a technical
- 8 standpoint, I don't have a problem provided that we have it
- 9 continue under advisement provided they supply the missing
- 10 component of the exhibits.
- 11 MR. BRUCE: That will be done immediately.
- 12 TECHNICAL EXAMINER McCLURE: That is obviously in
- 13 your discretion, Mr. Brancard.
- 14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other
- interested parties in this matter with comments?
- 16 (No audible response.)
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, we will
- 18 admit the exhibits you have provided. The case will be
- 19 taken under advisement, but the record will be left open to
- 20 allow you to submit the pooling checklist by the end of the
- 21 day. Is that possible?
- 22 MR. BRUCE: Oh, yes. Oh, yes. I imagine we will
- 23 get done here in an hour and a half or two, and I will get
- 24 them over to the division after 1.
- 25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Thank you.

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     With that cases 21795, 21796, 21797, 21798 are taken under
     advisement with the record open for the checklist.
