**SECOND AMENDED PRE-HEARING ORDER**

This Pre-Hearing Order follows a status conference held on May 20, 2021, before an Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) Hearing Examiner (“Examiner”), in which the hearing date was agreed to by all parties. The Examiner previously issued a Pre-Hearing Order on January 29, 2021, which was amended and restated on February 15, 2021 (“Pre-Hearing Order”). The Pre-Hearing Order is amended as follows:

1. The hearing will commence on August 20, 2021 following the completion of the Division’s regular hearing docket and continue as necessary through completion.
2. The parties shall file, with the pre-hearing statement required by 19.15.4.13.B NMAC, the following additional information, all of which is due by 5 p.m. no later than seven (7) calendar days before the hearing:
  - a. a list of material facts not in dispute;
  - b. a list of disputed facts and issues;
  - c. identification of the witnesses and their qualifications; and
  - d. a full narrative of the direct testimony and exhibits for each witness.
3. Any evidentiary objections to the filed direct testimony or any exhibit shall be filed by 5 p.m. no later than two (2) calendar days before the hearing and will be addressed at the commencement of the hearing.
4. All pleadings filed in this proceeding, including pre-hearing statements and exhibits, shall be filed through the Division’s online portal. The parties are not required to file a courtesy copy with the Examiner.

5. All provisions in the Pre-Hearing Order not amended or superseded by this Order remain in effect, including the provisions for order of presentations at the hearing.

6. Any requests for continuances or status conferences shall be filed in writing through the Division fee portal.
