Appearances for Apache. 6 MR. FELDEWERT: Michael Feldewert of the Santa Fe 7 office of Holland & Hart. 8 MR. PADILLA: Mr. Examiner, Ernest L. Padilla for 9 Colgate Operating. 10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. And I think I see an entry of appearance for EOG. 11 12 MR. RITTENHOUSE: Yes, sir. This is Joby 13 Rittenhouse of Beaty Wozniak on behalf of EOG. 14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I think I also see 15 COG for the Colgate cases. MS. MUNDS-DRY: Good morning, Mr. Hearing 16 Examiner, this is Ocean Munds-Dry on behalf of COG Operating 17 LLC. 18 19 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Do we have any other appearances in these eight matters? 20 21 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, can you hear me? 22 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I certainly can. 23 MR. BRUCE: I entered an appearance in all of the cases for MRC Permian Company. 24 25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Thank

3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So this is a status
4 conference. Who would like to start us off, Mr. Feldewert
5 or Mr. Padilla?

6 MR. FELDEWERT: I will step up, Mr. Examiner. 7 These -- we have some competing pooling cases here 8 involving Sections 8 and 9 in 19 South, 28 East. Both 9 companies seek to create four laydown 320 acre horizontal 10 spacing units in the Bone Spring formation.

I know that Apache was contacted. I believe Colgate was recently contacted as well as by the State Land Office who informed the parties there is now an unleased state tract in the SE/4, I believe it is, in Section 8, and that that is going to need to be nominated and leased before the properties can be developed.

So the parties are going to have to address that issue. So, in my mind, this is a probably a case that should be set for hearing late summer, early fall. HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Padilla? MR. PADILLA: I agree with that assessment by Mr. Feldewert. Colgate does not know if it should dismiss these applications or wait for the lease sale from the Land

25 the May sale. And we recently did a stipulation with the

Office. My understanding is this tract will be included in

Land Office on a case that's going to be heard last on the 1 2 docket where we had the same problem, an unleased state 3 tract, and if either Apache or Colgate are the successful 4 bidders, probably there won't be any problem in terms of 5 competing. 6 But if a third party comes in, I think that 7 well, I know that then you would have to make well proposals 8 to that third party and then attempt to force pool them if 9 there is no agreement. So I agree these cases need to be 10 moved to August or maybe even September. MR. PADILLA: Obviously if Colgate decides that 11 12 they are going to drop this case and do one-mile laterals, 13 which is something they are considering, then that's going 14 to be in the very near future. Otherwise we will just 15 continue this -- these cases which the State Land Office issue is resolved. 16 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Any comments from the other entries of appearance EOG, COG, MRC? 18 19 MR. RITTENHOUSE: EOG doesn't have any additional comments at this point. 20 21 MR. FELDEWERT: Same for MRC. 22 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Same for COG. 23 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Feldewert, is it 24 your preference to set a hearing, or are you looking at 25 possibly dismissing this?
