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1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Next up on our

- 2 list, then, is Cases 21803, 21804, 21805, Franklin
- 3 Mountain represented by Modrall Sperling.
- 4 DEANA BENNETT: Good morning, Mr. Examiner.
- 5 Deana Bennett on behalf of the Franklin
- 6 Mountain Energy.
- 7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you,
- 8 Ms. Bennett.
- 9 And I have Max and Starboard listed as
- 10 parties.
- 11 Holland & Hart?
- 12 ADAM RANKIN: Good morning, Mr. Hearing
- 13 Officer.
- 14 Adam Rankin appearing on behalf of the Max
- 15 Permian and Starboard Permian Resources, Holland &
- 16 Hart.
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. And
- 18 Burlington Resources?
- 19 MICHAEL RODRIGUEZ: Michael Rodriguez of
- 20 Hinkle Shanor on behalf of the Burlington Resources Oil
- and Gas Company, LP.
- 22 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 23 Mr Rankin, I believe you do not have an
- 24 objection to this case going forward by affidavit; is
- 25 that correct?

- 1 ADAM RANKIN: No objections.
- 2 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Rodriguez?
- 3 MICHAEL RODRIGUEZ: No objection. The
- 4 motion -- the appearance is actually entered just to
- 5 preserve our right to a de novo hearing at a later
- 6 date.
- 7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 8 Are there any other parties in Cases 21803,
- 9 21804, 21805?
- 10 Hearing none, Ms. Bennett, you may proceed.
- 11 DEANA BENNETT: Thank you very much,
- 12 Mr. Examiner.
- These three cases are companion cases to cases
- 14 that were heard on April 8th and -- for which orders
- 15 have already been issued.
- And I really appreciate the expediency with
- 17 which the division is issuing orders these cases. So
- 18 thank you for that.
- 19 These three cases involve the east half of
- 20 Sections 1 and 12, and the three cases speak -- units
- 21 are proposed wells in two Bone Spring units and a
- 22 Wolfcamp unit.
- 23 I'll briefly go through the packet, what's
- 24 included in each packet. But each packet is the same
- 25 except for the information related to the various

- 1 formations in each packet.
- 2 But the layout is the same of each packet.
- 3 So in the packet before you, for -- in each
- 4 case, we have included the compulsory pooling checklist
- 5 as Exhibit A -- or tab A.
- 6 Tab B includes the affidavit of Shelley
- 7 Albrecht, the land man who has previously testified
- 8 before the division, and her credentials have been
- 9 accepted as a matter of record.
- Behind her exhibit, you'll find -- or behind
- 11 her affidavit, you'll find the development overview
- 12 which, again, outlines both the west half and east half
- 13 development for this acreage.
- 14 Exhibit 2 is the application that we filed.
- 15 Exhibit 3 contains the C102 or C102s,
- 16 depending which case you're looking at.
- 17 Exhibit 4 has the lease tract map and
- 18 interest. And you'll see that the committed interests
- 19 here are in the 90 percent range. So Franklin has
- 20 either its interest or has obtained commitments from
- 21 others, putting it up in the 96 percent range.
- 22 Exhibit 5 is a summary of contacts.
- 23 Exhibit 6 contains the proposal letter.
- Exhibit 7 is the AFE.
- 25 And Exhibit 8 is the notice of affidavit

1 prepared by my office showing that notice letters were

- 2 timely sent and that publication was done timely.
- 3 Behind Tab C is the affidavit of Ben Kessel.
- 4 He's the geologist for Franklin Mountain Energy, and
- 5 he's previously testified. And his credentials have
- 6 been as a matter of record.
- 7 And his -- behind his affidavit, are the usual
- 8 exhibits: a locator map; a well board schematic; then
- 9 a structure map; cross-reference locator map; the
- 10 cross-reference logs themselves; the cross -- I'm sorry
- 11 -- a gross interval isacore; and then finally, an
- 12 excerpt from the (audio interference) that paper,
- 13 showing the justification for the orientation.
- 14 So each of the exhibit packets are the same.
- I did just want to point out that in Case
- 16 Number 21804, which involves the Wolfcamp formation,
- 17 there is a proximity tract well involved in that case.
- 18 It's the Mission Fed Com 705H well, and it's proposed
- 19 to be located closer than 330 feet from the east half,
- 20 east half section line, which allows Franklin to bring
- 21 in the full 640 acres of the east half.
- 22 Franklin has -- the land man testifies in --
- 23 in the case and in her declaration that she's
- 24 undertaking good faith efforts to obtain voluntary
- 25 joinder. And Franklin will continue to engage with

- 1 folks.
- And if they were able to reach an agreement,
- 3 then Franklin will inform the division that parties can
- 4 be removed from the list of parties to be pooled, which
- 5 is included in the materials as well.
- 6 With that, I'd ask the admission of case --
- 7 the exhibits in Case 21803, 21804, and 21805 be
- 8 admitted into the record, and that these cases be taken
- 9 under advisement.
- 10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 11 First, I'll check with Max Starboard.
- 12 Any questions or concerns?
- ADAM RANKIN: No questions, concerns, and no
- 14 objections.
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 16 And then Burlington Resources?
- 17 MICHAEL RODRIGUEZ: No objection.
- 18 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 19 Mr. Simmons? Any questions?
- 20 TECHNICAL EXAMINER SIMMONS: Everything
- 21 appears to be in order. Thank you.
- 22 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. I'll ask,
- 23 once again: Are there any other interested persons in
- 24 Cases 21803, '804, or '805?
- 25 Hearing and seeing none, the exhibits in these

Page 9 cases will be taken -- admitted into the record. And cases 21803, 21804 and 21805 will be taken under advisement. Thank you. DEANA BENNETT: Thank you very much. (Hearing concluded)
