Page 3 1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Next up are Cases 21891, 21892, and 21893, Mewbourne Oil. 2 3 Mr. Bruce, are you here for those? JAMES BRUCE: Yes, I represent Mewbourne. 4 5 Thank you. 6 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So let us see if there are any other interested parties in 7 cases 21891, 21892, 21893. 8 9 Hearing none, Mr. Bruce, you may proceed. 10 I assume you want to consolidate these three 11 cases. JAMES BRUCE: Yes. They're a little bit 12 13 different each, but they're -- they are all related. 14 So -- in one way or another. So, I'd move that they be consolidated. 15 And there is one exhibit package for all three 16 17 cases. HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Thank you. 18 Please go ahead. 19 20 JAMES BRUCE: In Case '891, Mewbourne seeks to pool the north half south half of Sections 9 and 10 in 21 22 20 South, 29 East for purposes of drilling a Bone 23 Spring well. The name is Perazzi. 24 In the same acreage, north half, south half of 25 Sections 9 and 10. They seek to force pool the

Page 4 Wolfcamp formation. Another Perazzi well. 1 2 And then in the final case, '893, they seek to force pool the south half, south half of Section 9, and 3 south half, south half of Section 10 for another 4 Perazzi Bone Spring well. 5 6 The exhibit packages are the normal amount, contain the normal data, land plats, exhibit 7 8 attachment. 9 The interest owners being pooled vary a little bit, and if you go to Exhibit 2, the land man's 10 affidavit and go to Attachments B1, B2, and B3, you'll 11 see that in the Bone Spring wells, the only person 12 13 being pooled is a gentleman named Michael Short in each 14 of those Bone Spring wells. In the Wolfcamp well, there are several 15 persons being force pooled, and that's the only 16 17 difference in ownership. 18 The -- at AFEs for the well are attached. 19 Exhibit 3, the geologist's affidavit contains both Bone Spring and Wolfcamp geology exhibits. 20 21 And finally, I got a cross-section to print up 22 okay. So we're okay on that instance. As to the notice, affidavit was sent to --23 24 there are two separate letters, one for the Wolfcamp wells and one for the -- two for the -- one for the 25

Page 5 Bone Spring wells and one for -- two Wolfcamp wells. 1 2 There -- there were some unlocateable parties. 3 These are people that didn't pick up their certified mail, or there is one company Siete Oil and Gas 4 Corporation, which is a defunct corporation. 5 As a result, there is -- that notice was 6 published as against all the parties in the Wolfcamp 7 well unit. 8 9 And where the notice issues arose, notice was 10 not -- affidavit of publication was not necessary for 11 the Bone -- the Bone Spring wells. 12 With that, the exhibit package is complete, 13 for a change. And I'd move the admission of Exhibits 1 14 through 6 and ask that the matters be taken under 15 advisement. 16 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Mr. Simmons, any questions? 18 19 TECHNICAL EXAMINER SIMMONS: So it looks like there's -- there's two wells that are going to be 20 21 completed in the north half of the south half, and I 22 thought that I heard Mr. Bruce say -- state that there 23 was the last -- the third application was also going to be in the south half of the south half. 24 25 So there may be a discrepancy there, but I

Page 6 think we can -- we can work through that when the --1 2 when it's reviewed, and I can communicate with him 3 then. JAMES BRUCE: Yeah. There -- yeah. There are 4 two wells in the north half, south half, one -- one 5 Bone Spring and one Wolfcamp. And then in the 6 7 adjoining well unit, there is simply a Bone Spring well. 8 9 TECHNICAL EXAMINER SIMMONS: Okay. I 10 thought -- all right. Great. 11 Well, it looks like -- if there is a discrepancy, we'll communicate, but that looks like 12 13 that cleared it. Thank you. 14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Anything further? 15 JAMES BRUCE: No. HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any 16 other interested parties in Cases 21891, 21892, and 17 18 21893? 19 Hearing none, we will admit the exhibits in these cases, and Cases 21891, 21892, and 21893 will be 20 21 taken under advisement. 22 (Hearing concluded) 23 24 25
