Page 3 1 (Time noted 10:14 a.m.) 2 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I call now Item 2, 3 Case 21842, Notice of Violation issued to Dwight A. 4 Tipton and Zimmerman Oil and Gas Exploration, Inc. For the Division? 5 MR. AMES: Mr. Hearing Examiner, Eric Ames with 6 7 the Office of the General Counsel. 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Is there anybody here on behalf of the 9 Respondents? 10 11 Zac Zimmerman. MR. ZIMMERMAN: Yes. 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Mr. Zimmerman, I did not see in the record any Answer or 13 14 Entry of Appearance. Could you please state what your 15 position is with the Respondent and what you would like to 16 do today. 17 MR. ZIMMERMAN: We would like for you guys to hold off on issuing, you know, any kind of a decision so 18 that we have further time to discuss with OCD. 19 20 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And what is your 21 position with the Respondent? 22 MR. ZIMMERMAN: Sorry. I'm the president of Zimmerman Oil and Gas Exploration. 23 24 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. But 25 if we go forward with the case today do you have any

1 statement to make or otherwise?

2 MR. ZIMMERMAN: No. Just to hold off on the 3 decision.

4 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 5 Mr. Ames, I could treat this as a request I would like to hear your response. б for a continuance. 7 MR. AMES: Thank you, Mr. Hearing Examiner. This is an interesting situation. 8 There are two Respondents here, Mr. Dwight A. Tipton and 9 Zimmerman Oil and Gas Exploration. Mr. Tipton is the 10 registered operator for the wells but Mr. Tipton passed 11 12 away a few years ago. Zimmerman Oil is operated by a relative of Mr. Tipton and has been, in reality, operating 13 the wells essentially on Mr. Tipton's behalf for a number 14 15 of years. And that's why there are two Respondents here. 16 There is apparently no representative of the Estate making 17 an appearance today. But I will say that OCD has discussed this 18 matter with Mr. Zimmerman and Mrs. Zimmerman. 19 We would like to proceed with this case and present our testimony, 20 21 and then at the conclusion of the case request a period of time before an Order is entered so that we can discuss 22

with Mr. Zimmerman, Mr. And Mrs. Zimmerman, a path forwardto resolution prior to Order.

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So while we endorse Mr. Zimmerman's request

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Page 5 to hold off on issuing an Order, we would like to proceed 1 2 with the case itself, and I do not understand 3 Mr. Zimmerman to be asking for a continuance. 4 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Zimmerman, is that okay if we go forward? 5 MR. ZIMMERMAN: Yes, that's fine. б 7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Thank you. With that I will have the Division move 8 ahead with its case in chief. 9 Thank you, Mr. Brancard. OCD would 10 MR. AMES: like to proceed in essentially the same manner as we just 11 12 did for Flare Oil, and given that Mr. Zimmerman doesn't intend to -- has not filed an Answer and doesn't intend to 13 14 present any testimony, we think that would be appropriate. 15 If Mr. Zimmerman would like to ask questions of the 16 witness regarding the testimony that's in the Prehearing 17 Statement, with which Mr. Zimmerman has been served, we obviously have no objection to that, but in lieu of 18 reciting all the testimony into the record we would like 19 to proceed with a truncated form in the manner we just did 20 21 with Flare Oil. 22 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Please go ahead, and you can sort of preempt my questions by 23 24 providing the outline of violations and sanctions as we 25 discussed in the first case.

Page 6 1 MR. AMES: Great. Thank you. 2 OCD calls Daniel Sanchez. 3 JOSE DANIEL SANCHEZ, 4 having been duly sworn testified as follows: 5 EXAMINATION BY MR. AMES: 6 7 Q. Daniel, please state your full name for the 8 record. Jose Daniel Sanchez. 9 Α. 10 Q. And Daniel, where do you work? I work for the Oil Conservation Division, a 11 Α. division of the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources 12 13 Department. 14 Q. How long have you worked there? 15 Over 16 years. Α. 16 What is your job there? 0. 17 Α. I am the Administration and Compliance Bureau Chief. 18 19 Q. Did you prepare written testimony in this case? Yes, I did. 20 Α. 21 Was that testimony submitted with the Division's Q. 22 Prehearing Statement in this case? 23 Yes, it was. Α. 24 Is that testimony accurately reflected in Q. 25 Section 2 of the Prehearing Statement under the tab Direct

1 Testimony?

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Α.	Yes,	it	is.
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3 Q. Let's briefly review your testimony. What is 4 the first alleged violation in the NOV? The first violation is a violation of 5 Α. 19.15.9.9(B). That's failing to transfer Tipton's wells. 6 7 Mr. Tipton passed away on March 24th of 2020, and Zimmerman told the OCD that it was operating the wells 8 before his death and continued to operate Tipton's wells 9 after his death without OCD's approval for change of 10 11 operator.

12 Q. What sanction does OCD propose for this13 violation?

A. It's requesting an Order terminating Zimmerman's
authority to transport from Tipton's wells, and also
imposes a civil penalty of \$60,000.

17 0. What is the second violation that's alleged in 18 the NOV? And in terms of reciting these violations, 19 Daniel, I think we just need to give the citation and a very brief description of the violation itself as listed 20 in the first or second sentence of the NOV. We don't need 21 22 to recite all the testimony as part of the alleged 23 violation. 24 Α. The second violation is 19.15.5.9(A)(4)(a), and 25 that's in excess of inactive wells as required by the

Page 8 1 rule. 2 What sanction does OCD propose for this 0. 3 violation? 4 We are requesting that -- I'm sorry. Α. 5 Look on page 3. It's the first full paragraph. 0. For this violation. Do you see that? 6 7 Α. Yes. Yes. OCD is requesting that David Zimmerman plug and abandon two of the inactive wells 8 identified in the testimony, and we are also requesting a 9 civil penalty of \$1,000. 10 11 ο. Thank you. What is the third violation alleged 12 in the NOV? 13 Α. This is a violation of Rule 19.15.8.9(C), and it's insufficient financial assurance. 14 15 What sanction is proposed here? 0. 16 We are requesting that Zimmerman -- Tipton and Α. Zimmerman increase their current financial insurance from 17 \$50,000 to \$125,000, and we are also requesting a civil 18 penalty of \$10,500. 19 20 And what is the final violation alleged in the Q. 21 NOV? This is also insufficient financial assurance 22 Α. for wells that have exceeded the two-year inactivity rule. 23 That is under 19.15.8.9(D). And what we are requesting 24 25 here is that financial assurance for the two wells on page

Page 9 29, No. 4 and No. 6, be submitted, or in lieu of 1 2 single-well bonds, a T.A. blanket bond in the amount of 3 \$150,000. And we are also requesting a civil penalty of \$15,000. 4 5 Thank you. Let's move on to the exhibits which 0. б is Section 3 of the not of high violation at the top of 7 page 5? 8 I see 15 exhibits listed here. Could you briefly identify each exhibit for the record. 9 Exhibit 1 is my curriculum vitae. 10 Α. 11 Exhibit 2 is the Notice of Violation that 12 was issued. 13 Exhibit 3 is a well list for Tipton wells. Exhibit 4 is the obituary of Mr. Dwight A. 14 15 Tipton. 16 Exhibit 5 is a civil penalty calculation used for that particular violation. 17 18 Exhibit 5 are the C-145 reports. 19 Exhibit 7 is an OCD email to Zimmerman on 20 March 3, 2021. 21 Exhibit 8 is an email to the OCD in 22 response to that email. 23 Exhibit 9 is an OCD email back to Zimmerman 24 on March 9. 25 Exhibits 10, 11 and 12 are the civil

Page 10 penalty calculations for the final three violations. 1 Exhibit 13 is the certified mail for the 2 3 NOVs that were sent out. 4 Exhibit 14 is the UPS tracking page for the delivery to Tipton. 5 Exhibit 15 is the UPS tracking page for the б 7 delivery to Zimmerman. MR. AMES: Thank you, Daniel. 8 OCD now offers these exhibits for the 9 record. 10 11 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 12 Any objection, Mr. Zimmerman? 13 MR. ZIMMERMAN: No. 14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So these exhibits 15 are admitted. 16 Is there anything further from your 17 witness, Mr. Ames? 18 MR. AMES: No, Mr. Hearing Examiner. 19 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Zimmerman, do you have any questions for this witness? 20 21 MR. ZIMMERMAN: No questions. 22 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 23 And so finally, Mr. Ames, Any further 24 evidence today in this case? 25 MR. AMES: No, Mr. Hearing Examiner.

Page 11 1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 2 Mr. Zimmerman, any statement at this point? 3 MR. ZIMMERMAN: None. 4 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Okay. The proposal on the table, then, is 5 that the Division and Mr. Zimmerman be given a time frame 6 7 to continue discussions before the Division submits its proposed Findings and Conclusions to the hearing examiner. 8 What time frame are you thinking of, 9 Mr. Ames? 10 MR. AMES: Yes, Mr. Hearing Examiner. That's a 11 12 good question. 13 First may I ask what time frame do you 14 anticipate or would you impose for the Flare Oil on which 15 there's no delay requested? 16 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Good question, 17 because I forgot to bring that up. I would love two weeks but I don't know if 18 that works with your schedule. 19 MR. AMES: I will endeavor to do two weeks. 20 If 21 I require additional time I will request it from the 22 hearing examiner. 23 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. 24 MR. AMES: With respect -- I'm sorry. Go ahead. 25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Go ahead.

Page 12 1 MR. AMES: Okay. Thank you. 2 With respect to the current case, the 3 pending case now, I would request, uhm, 30 days to submit Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law if we can't reach 4 resolution of the matter informally. 5 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Zimmerman, is 6 7 that a fair enough time frame to work on this? 8 MR. ZIMMERMAN: I think so. HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And of course you 9 can always request an extension if you are in the middle 10 of productive negotiations. 11 12 MR. ZIMMERMAN: Thank you. 13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. With that the exhibits are admitted in this case, and we are 14 15 requesting Finding and Conclusions from the Division to be 16 submitted 30 days from now during which time the Division 17 and Mr. Zimmerman may conduct additional discussions and 18 perhaps resolve this matter. 19 Anything else on this matter, Mr. Ames, Mr. Zimmerman? 20 21 MR. AMES: No, sir. 22 MR. ZIMMERMAN: No, sir. 23 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you, 24 appreciate it. 25 MR. AMES: Mr. Zimmerman, I will call later

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1	today and we can pick up where we left off.
2	MR. ZIMMERMAN: Good. Thank you.
