SAVAGE: Good morning. Darin Savage with Abadie & Schill appearing on behalf of Devon Energy 6 7 Production Company, LP. 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And I have EOG, Holland & Hart. 9 MR. RANKIN: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Adam 10 Rankin with the Law Firm of Holland & Hart appearing on 11 12 both these cases on behalf of EOG Resources, Inc. 13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Does EOG have 14 objections to these cases going forward by affidavit? 15 MR. RANKIN: No objection to these cases 16 proceeding by affidavit. 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Any other interested parties in Cases 21924, 21925? 18 19 Hearing none, Mr. Savage you may proceed. MR. SAVAGE: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. 20 21 We are presenting in consolidated form Cases 21924 and 21925. These cases cover Section 17, 8 22 and 5, Township 23 South, Range 31 East, in Eddy County, 23 24 New Mexico. 25 The landman Katie Adams for these cases has

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Page 5 testified before the Division, her credentials have been 1 2 accepted and made a matter of record, as well as the 3 geologist's Kasmiri Workman. In case No. 21924 Devon seeks an order 4 5 creating a standard 399.88-acre spacing unit, Section 5 -correction, comprised of the west half/east half of б 7 Section 5 and 8 and the west half/northeast of Section 17 and pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring 8 Formation. 9 The unit has been dedicated to the Figi 10 17-5 Fed Com for the 233H well. Orientation of the well 11 is standup south to north, and all setback requirements 12 under statewide rules are met. 13 Ms. Adams' Exhibit A for Case 21924 14 15 includes her Landman Affidavit, the C-102, Ownership 16 breakdown, the Well Proposal Letter with AFE, and the 17 Chronology of Contacts showing good faith negotiations. Ms. Workman's Exhibit B for this case 18 19 includes her Geology Affidavit along with the five standard geology exhibits, showing good potential for 20 21 development. Exhibit C provides the Affidavit of Notice 22 for mailings and location Notice. Notice was timely sent 23 24 and published to account for two unlocatable parties, John

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R. McConn and Khody Land & Minerals, who are overriding

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1 royalty intereset owners.

Both Ms. Adams and Ms. Workman affirm that the approval of this application is in the best interests of conservation, protection of correlative rights and the prevention of waste, and will prevent the drilling of unnecessarily wells.

7 Next, in Case 21925 Devon seeks an Order creating a standard 399.82-acre spacing unit, more or 8 less, comprised of the east half/east half of Sections 5 9 and 8 and the east half/northeast of Section 17, and 10 pooling all uncommitted interest owners in the Bone Spring 11 12 Formation, as well. The unit will be dedicated to the Figi 17-5 Fed Com 234H well. Orientation of the well is 13 14 standup, south to north, and setback requirements are met. 15 Ms. Adams again, in Exhibit A -- she 16 combined her exhibits for both cases, but in Case 21925 17 includes her Landman Affidavit, the C-102, an Ownership Breakdown, the Well Proposal Letter and AFE, and a 18 Chronology of Contacts. 19 Ms. Workman's Exhibit B for this case 20 21 includes her Geology Affidavit along with the five 22 standard geology exhibits. The geology exhibits for both

23 cases are combined in the same exhibits.

24 Exhibit C provides the Affidavit of Notice 25 for mailings and publication, and again it was timely sent
